PREFACE

The Federal-State Market News Service collected daily apple shipments beginning August 4, 1999. Collection of shipping point price information and issuance of the daily Market Report for the 1999 season crop began August 10, 1999. The last f.o.b. report was issued April 16, 2000. Domestic and export shipments were collected separately and shipments were collected until April 30, 2000 although a few shippers continued to ship product through the summer months.

This summary was prepared by the Federal-State Market News Service located in Jessup, MD. This office is operated by the United States Department of Agriculture Agricultural Marketing Service in cooperation with the Maryland, Pennsylvania, Virginia and West Virginia State Departments of Agriculture.

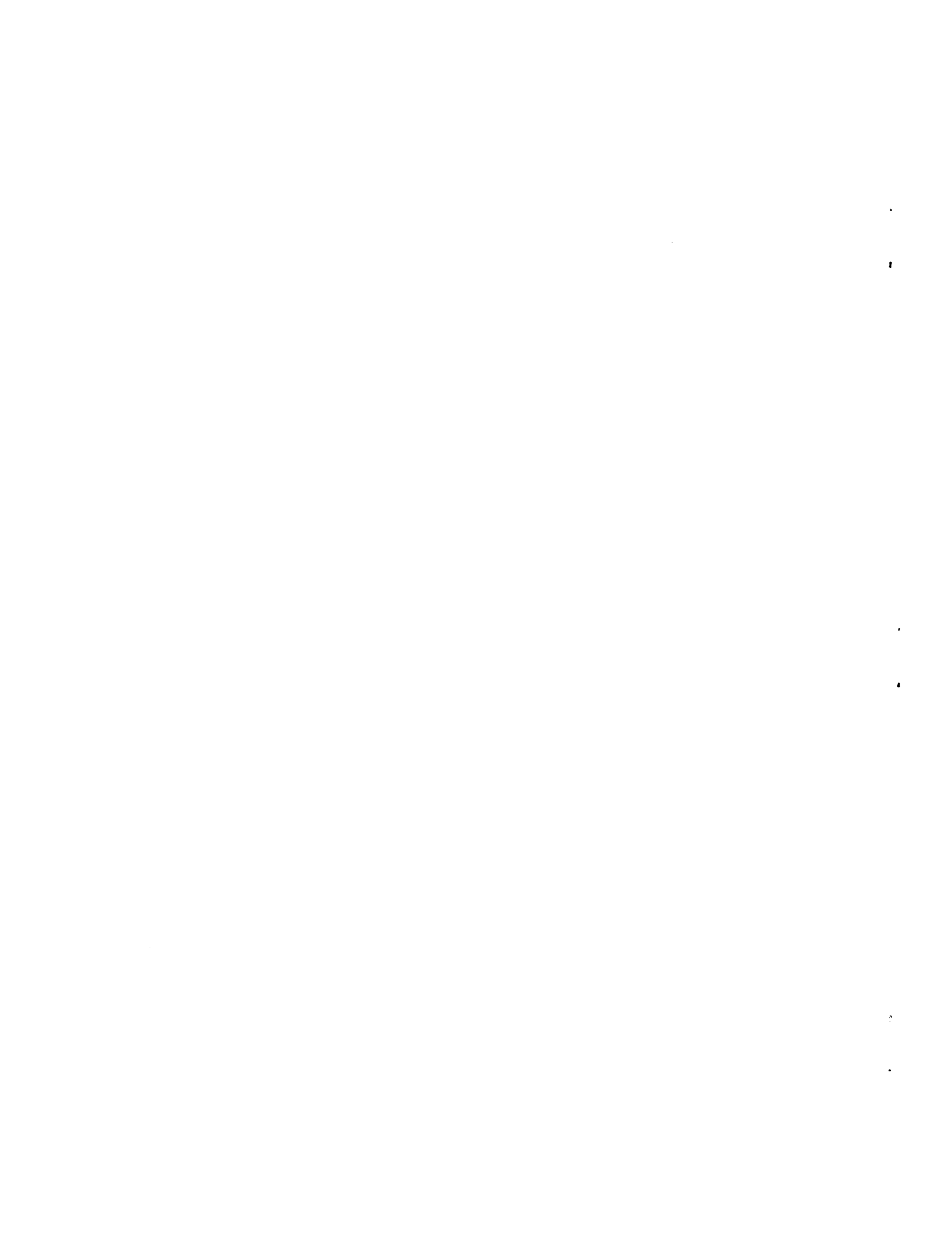

REVIEW OF THE 1999-2000 APPALACHIAN DISTRICT APPLE SEASON

MARKETING: The season was right on schedule despite the summer drought and heavy rains in late August and September. Apples were their sweetest ever and packouts were higher than expected. Cool weather in Septemeber and October helped color apples. There were a few reports concerning a problem of retaining labor for harvest. Market News issued the first price f.o.b. August 10, 1999. Heavy volume on the eastern seaboard and in competing growing areas in the states and abroad pushed prices lower than the previous season. The hot, dry weather in the southern part of the Appalachian District caused sunburn of some fruit. Some growers choose not to harvest all of their fruit because of the low prices, heavy volume, and/or fruit condition resulting in some fruit being left in the orchards. Parts of the New York crop was affected by a wind and hail storm in September and Washington experienced hot, damp stressful weather during their harvest, which also resulted in lower quality fruit. Harvest was finished by late October. Decreased sales to Asia, Mexico, and Latin America coupled with large supplies in competing domestic areas led to lighter demand and lower prices during mid-November and December. By January, prices had decreased \$2.00-3.00 to their lowest point from their September levels. Below normal export movement was due to troubled economies around the globe and normal export markets were using lower priced fruit from Chile and the Northwest. The Washington state crop was larger sized than normal due to abundant rain and the eastern states had the more small size fruit, which export countries desired. Retail chain store promotions and the school lunch program helped move much of the eastern fruit. These chain promotions, in particular the Eastern Select promotions, were offered during mid-September through mid-December and from January to March. A hard freeze hit the California citrus crop and mid-western snow storms in January slightly increased movement for eastern shippers. Golden Delicious moved very good throughout the season. Red Delicious moved moderately for tray packed 100s and larger; however, movement was fair on Red Delicious bags due to a heavier than average volume on small, Combination grade apples. New York competed heavily for market share on their Red Rome variety. Controlled atmosphere rooms were opened by mid-February and the apples brought \$.50-1.00 higher than regular storage. A few shippers opened rooms before certification for supplies of special storage Golden Delicious. Fresh market prices increased in March and April by \$2.00-3.00 for Golden Delicious and \$1.00-2.00 for Red Delicious and Red Rome. At this time many shippers had finished for the season and supplies of larger sized eastern apples decreased. Processors raised the market for juice apples and a few shippers diverted their fresh market supplies of small Red Delicious apples to the processors because of sluggish fresh market movement. The last f.o.b. price report was issued April 16, 2000.

PRODUCTION AND SHIPMENTS: The Appalachian District total production was 1045 million pounds of apples according to August 2000 reports on total production compiled by the United States Department of Agriculture, National Agriculture Statistics Service (NASS). This was approximately 22% higher than 1998's crop of 820 million pounds and 8% higher than 1997's production of 966 million pounds. Total U.S. production for 1999-2000 season was 10,580 million pounds. This figure was 9% lower than 1998's U.S. production of 11,646.4 million pounds. The final Appalachian District production figures for 1996, 1995 and 1994 were 800, 1,100, and 890 million pounds respectively.

Production estimates by individual states in million pounds for 1999, 1998, 1997 and 1996 respectively were: Maryland 38, 35, 45, 28; Pennsylvania 505, 395, 525, 391; Virginia 360, 280, 262, 260; and West Virginia 145, 110, 110, 100. Total fresh shipments of the 1999 Appalachian crop as collected by the Market News Service through May 30, 2000 were 2,235 loads based on 40,000 pounds per load (8,941 10,000 pound

units). This is a 16% increase from 1998's 1,888 loads (collected through April 30, 1999). Shipments from past seasons are as follows: 1997 - 2,455 loads, 1996 - 1,815 loads, 1995 - 2,597 loads. Domestic shipments through May 30, 2000 totaled 1,934 loads. In 1998-1999, 1,764 loads were shipped domestically through April 30, 1999. The most active shipping weeks occurred the weeks ending October 23 and December 11 with 85 and 75 loads, respectively. An occasional shipper continued to move fruit through the summer; however, these figures were not collected. Like last season, the heaviest shipping weeks corresponded with retail promotions. Export movement for the 1999-2000 season was excellent for this area due to the excellent color, quality and small size of the fruit. Total export shipments as collected by Market News were 302 loads compared to 124 loads for 1998-99. This is a substantial 59% increase from the 1998 season. In 1997, 275 loads were exported. The period of most active export movement occurred the week ending December 11 with 42 loads exported. Last years busiest export week occurred the week ending December 21, 1998 with 21 loads. Appalachian District apples were exported to the following countries during the 1999 season: Barbados, Canada, Colombia, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Finland, Guatemala, Honduras, Israel, Nicaragua, Panama, Puerto Rico, Surinam, Sweden, Trinidad, and Venezuela.

GROWING CONDITIONS AND HARVEST: The spring bloom period experienced freezing temperatures on April 9 and 10 with temperatures in the low to mid twenties. A few areas experienced temperatures in the high teens on the evening of the ninth. Some damage occurred; however, the damage was very spotty within the orchards. The late spring brought good pollination and good growing conditions with ample rainfall. By late summer, fruit maturity and color lagged due to unusually hot, dry weather conditions, which continued into the fall harvest. Severe drought conditions were experienced in most areas of the Appalachia with water tables well below normal. This caused the fruit to remain small and not color as well. In addition, the dry, hot weather caused some fruit to sunburn in the lower Appalachian District. Some growers who had irrigation were able to produce some larger sized fruit. The dry weather increased sugar content and improved storage quality, which was a plus for processors and storage fruit. Quality of the Golden Delicious, Red Delicious, and Red Rome varieties was reported to be the best they have been in years; however, size was lacking. By late October, harvest was complete and temperatures were finally more seasonable. Water tables remained below normal. Apple bearing acreage and yield per acre for 1999 was reported at 461,500 bearing acres at 11.5 tons per acre. The 1998 figure was 467,600 acres at 12.5 tons per acre as reported by NASS.

PACKAGING AND MARKETING: The predominant packs were tray packed cartons and 12 3-lb film bag containers. Also in large volume were 8 5-lb film bags and a few 10 4-pound bags. An occasional shipper packed heavy packs, loose bushels, and film over wrapped trays. Most domestic tray pack demand was for fruit sized 88s-100s; however, heaviest volume on Red Delicious ran to size 125s, Golden Delicious to size 100s, and Red Rome to sizes 88s-100s. Export demand was for fruit sized 113s-125s.

TRANSPORTATION TRENDS: All apples from the Appalachian District are moved by truck. Availability of trucks for the season was generally adequate except from January to May when availability was short due to difficulty in obtaining full load orders and the sharp increase in fuel prices kept many drivers off the roads. The Market News truck rate report from the Appalachian District reported prices of \$90.00 per load for a 45-48' trailer from the Appalachian District to New York City, NY. This was based on a 40,000 container load. Also, due to sharp increases in fuel prices, many transportation companies were charging this base rate plus fuel surcharges in varying amounts to transport apples.

REVIEW OF THE 1999-2000 PROCESSED APPLE SEASON

A severe drought and above normal temperatures plagued the Mid-Atlantic states during the summer resulting in smaller sized apples with high sugar, quality and color. Crop volume was very large and there was no shortage of supply of juice apples the entire season; although large sized canners (2 ¾" and larger) were more difficult to obtain. Harvesting occurred around the seasonal norm. There were only slight reports of drops and limb damage caused by rains and wind from hurricane Floyd in mid-September. These late rains helped the apples size. September demand for juice and canners ranged from good to moderate. Processors had used up most of their summer inventories and during September and October they were very busy filling retail orders. October proved very busy with very heavy supplies causing a shortage of bins and storage space. Despite the small size, apple pack outs were higher than earlier predictions. Most processors built up yard supplies and were not as worried about fruit keeping like they had been last year. A few had made purchases from North Carolina on premium grade and large sized canner fruit. Apple quality was outstanding with very little russeting on Golden Delicious and the Red Romes had the best color in years. Harvesting slowed by late October and by early November storages were full. In November, processors concentrated on building up warehouse inventories. Demand slowed in December to fairly light levels with steady prices. At this point many growers had heavy supplies of apples without homes, especially Red Delicious and despite some warm weather during these months, the apples held their firmness very well. Most processors were busy using yard supplies. Trading was very slow during January and February with most movement being contracted fruit. Some regular storage fruit was available into February; although by this time their condition was variable. Most processors were purchasing or taking only controlled atmosphere fruit and growers were dumping packing line culls as processors were not able to use them. In late April most of the small cider operations were finished pressing for the season.

The first Market News price report was issued Wednesday, September 22, 1999. The majority of canner and juice fruit moved on a contractual basis with a few open sales. All fruit was under Federal-State inspection. Processed tonnage prices for canner fruit were generally steady during the season from their September contracted prices. This is slightly lower than last season. U.S. No. One grade fruit delivered to processors and paid to sized 2 ½-2 ¾ inches per hundredweight were \$8.00-9.00 for Golden Delicious, Stayman \$7.25-8.50, York, Spy and Granny Smith \$8.50-9.25, Red Rome \$7.25-7.75 and Tree Run Red Delicious and Law Rome \$6.00. The one exception was a \$2.00 decrease on Red Delicious to \$4.00-6.00 in late November due to extremely heavy supplies in the District and in areas to the north and south. Occasionally processors paid slightly highly prices for premium sized Golden Delicious controlled atmosphere fruit. Straight loads of juice stock per ton U.S. Cider grade or better, including contract sales, delivered to processors and paid to growers opened at \$4.00-5.00 mostly \$4.00-4.50 on September 22, 1999 and followed a declining pattern. This price was about the same as last years price. Although juice demand was good during harvest, heavy supplies caused the price to decreased to mostly \$4.00 the following week. In late November the price decreased again to \$3.50-4.00 and then to \$3.00-3.50 in February. Juice prices remained at that level of trading for the remainder of the reporting period, which ended June 7, 2000.
