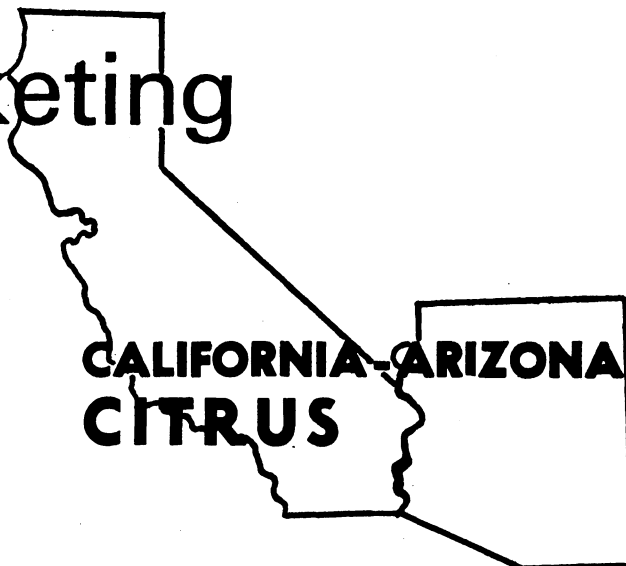

F O R E W O R D

Daily market reports on Citrus Fruits were issued from the Los Angeles Office of the Federal-State Market News Service during the 1966-1967 Season. From these reports and from reports released by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Washington, D.C., the California Crop and Livestock Reporting Service, Sacramento, California, the Orange and Lemon Administrative Committees, Los Angeles, California, and the Grapefruit Administrative Committee, Phoenix, Arizona, the data in the following summary is furnished.

Shipments, unloads and other similar data for the 1966-67 Season are considered final, representing the Citrus Crop Season from the first of November, 1966, to the end of October, 1967. We have endeavored to include information which will be of most value to the industry.

MARKETING

CALIFORNIA AND ARIZONA CITRUS

The United States Citrus production for the crop year 1966-1967 was approximately 271 million boxes, 33 percent above the previous season and 44 percent above the 1961-1965 average. The orange crop was substantially larger than the previous season reflecting an increase of approximately 47.5 million boxes. Sharp increases were especially noted in Florida. The Grapefruit crop of 55.8 million boxes was 9.1 million boxes above the 1965-1966 crop and 15.9 million boxes above the 1961-1965 average. Grapefruit production was down slightly in both Arizona and California, while up in Florida and Texas. Crop reports indicated Lemon production was up nearly 2 million boxes from the previous season and 2.3 million boxes more than the 1961-1965 average. Only a slight increase in Limes is noted while Tangerines reflect a substantial increase.

Processors took substantial portions of the 1966-1967 citrus crop. According to the Crop Reporting Board, approximately 73 percent of the oranges were processed, 27 percent moved to fresh markets and export outlets. Grapefruit moving to processors accounted for 55 percent of the crop and 45 percent marketed fresh. Reports indicate 56 percent of the lemons moved to fresh markets and export outlets and 44 percent processed.

ORANGES

The United States orange crop for 1966-1967, reported at 188,610,000 boxes by the Crop Reporting Board, was 25 percent larger than the previous season and 37 percent above the 1961-1965 average. The increase in production was noted in all production areas except for California Navels.

California's Navel and miscellaneous varieties production of 17,400,000 boxes was 9 percent below the previous season, but 21 percent above average. Valencias were up 2.2 million boxes, or 11 percent, and substantially above the 1961-1965 average of 15.9 million boxes. California's orange production was 20 percent of the U.S. total. Florida's share was 77 percent, and Arizona, Texas and Louisiana accounted for the remaining 3 percent.

The bearing acreage of the 1966-1967 California orange crop and total value as reported by the California Crop and Livestock Reporting Service is shown as follows: for Navels and miscellaneous varieties 65,020 acres with a total value of \$56,353,000 and Valencias 64,860 acres valued at \$48,646,000.

Yields per acre were reported at 268 boxes for Navels and 308 boxes for Valencias. Yields for Navels were below the previous season, while Valencias reflected slightly heavier yields. The average season price per box for Navels was \$3.31 as compared to \$2.90 the previous season, while Valencias show a lower average, \$2.46 as compared to \$3.25 last season.

Movement of the 1966-1967 California orange crop to the fresh market began with shipments of Navels from the Edison and Central Districts during the week ending November 6, 1966 when a total of 80 carloads moved to market. Volume increased rapidly thereafter as all districts became active. Peak Navel shipments were reached during the week ending December 11, 1966 when 1,562 carlot equivalents moved to market. Shipments declined rather sharply during the weeks ending December 25 and January 1, a normal reaction following the Holidays. By the end of January shipments had again moved upward to a volume of slightly over 1,000 carloads per week and held at this level through the third week in May. Valencia

shipments began during the week ending February 5, 1967 with limited supplies available from the Arizona and California Desert Valley districts. Following a normal trend, movement increased slowly until the week ending April 16th, when 255 carloads were shipped to market. Peak shipments were reached during the week ending June 11th when 1,012 carloads moved from all districts

Utilization reports of the 1966-1967 Navel orange crop reflect 16 percent going to processing, 81 percent moving fresh to domestic markets and 3 percent exported. Processors took 40 percent of the Valencia orange crop, while 45 percent moved to fresh market and 15 percent was exported.

Fruit size composition of both Navel and Valencia shipments from Central California districts averaged larger than during the previous season, while in other California and Arizona districts only the Navels averaged larger. Valencias show a slightly smaller average size.

Sales of Navel oranges at shipping point reflect lower prices for the larger sizes (88s and larger) as compared to sales of the previous season. On the otherhand the smaller oranges, (113-163s) in lighter volume brought prices averaging slightly above the 1965-1966 season. Valencia sales opened at price levels slightly below the previous season and were generally slightly below for all sizes throughout the marketing season.

Sales at Eastern auction markets for California Navels averaged slightly above the previous season. Total Navel sales at all Eastern auction markets during the 1966-1967 season were 3,240,466 cartons averaging \$3.38 for a total value of \$10,956,132. This compares to the preceding year of 3,010,171 cartons averaging \$3.32 and a total value of \$9,993,769.72. Volume sales of Valencias began in late April and continued active through the summer months. The total volume sold at all Eastern auction markets for the season was 3,077,003 cartons averaging \$3.38 for a total value of \$10,390,937. This compares to 3,013,279 cartons, for the previous season, averaging \$3.61 and a total value of \$11,003,280.

LEMONS

The 1966-1967 Lemon crop of 18,110,000 boxes was 10 percent above the previous season and 13 percent above the 1961-1965 average. California's share of the production was 15.3 million boxes, one million boxes above the previous season. Arizona's production of 2,810,000 boxes was up 840,000 boxes from 1965-1966 and 1.4 million boxes above the 1961-1965 average.

Movement of the 1966-1967 crop to fresh market started with limited shipments from Arizona during the week ending September 10, 1966 when 1 carload was exported. Shipments during the balance of September and October were generally light but showed a gradual upward trend. By the first week in November when both Central and Southern California districts became active, shipments had reached slightly over 200 carlots per week. Peak movement to fresh market was reached during the week ending June 17th when 527 carlots moved to domestic markets.

(L E M O N S, continued)

Disposition of the 1966-1967 crop shows 34 percent going to domestic markets, 17 percent exported and 49 percent processed. Total industry movement as reported by the Lemon Administrative Committee was 38,610 carlots as compared to 34,144 during the 1965-1966 season.

The bearing acreage of the California crop was reported to be 40,470 acres. Although bearing acreage was below the previous season, yields of 378 boxes per acre were 50 boxes above the previous year. The season's average price as reported by the Crop Reporting Service of \$3.33 per box was down only 7 cents from the 1965-1966 season. Value of the total production was shown at \$50,949,000. This compares to \$46,920,000 for the previous crop year.

Shipping point prices, as a whole, opened the season at levels substantially above the previous season. The smaller sizes (165s-235s) held higher prices throughout the season, while the larger sizes fell below the previous season during the period from the second week in January through the fourth week in August. Sales at Eastern auctions for the season totaled 2,453,568 cartons averaging \$4.40 for a total value of \$10,796,011. This compares to the previous seasons volume of 2,554,643 cartons averaging \$4.41 and a total value of \$11,265,975.63.

G R A P E F R U I T

The United States grapefruit production for 1966-1967 was reported to be 55,880,000 boxes, 16.5 percent above the previous season and 28.6 percent above the 1961-1965 average. Increases were especially noted in Florida where production of all varieties was up 9.3 million boxes from the previous year and in Texas where production was up by 2.2 million boxes. California showed an increase of only 150,000 boxes while Arizona was down 1.3 million boxes. Florida's share of the United States production was 78 percent, Texas 10 percent, California 9 percent and Arizona 3 percent.

(G R A P E F R U I T, continued)

Yields in California's Desert Valleys were 338 boxes per acre, down 16 boxes per acre as compared to the previous season. In other California districts yields of 477 boxes per acre reflect an increase of 18 boxes per acre over the previous crop year. There were 12,800 bearing acres of grapefruit in California during the 1966-1967 season with a total crop value of \$10,051,000 as compared to 12,550 acres and a crop value of \$12,001,000 during the previous season.

Shipments to fresh market started with limited movement from Arizona during the week ending November 26, 1966. Volume continued light until late December when supplies from California became available and the combined volume from both states reached slightly over 100 carloads per week. Reports released by the Grapefruit Administrative Committee show 2,467 carlots of California Desert fruit moving fresh to Domestic markets, 228 cars to export and 2,624 cars processed. From the Arizona crop, 1,651 cars moved fresh to Domestic markets, 203 cars exported and 1,461 cars processed. Markets in the eleven Western States and Canada received approximately 85 percent of the fresh movement from the California-Arizona Desert crop, while 16 percent moved to markets in other states.
