P R E F A C E

This publication summarizes the 1970 California nectarine marketing season and contains information compiled by the Sacramento office of the Federal-State Market News Service. This office is operated by the California Department of Agriculture, Bureau of Market News, in cooperation with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Consumer and Marketing Service.

The statistical tables of this summary contain movement, distribution and price information.

F.o.b. shipping point prices for the Southern San Joaquin Valley were reported during June 8-August 4, 1970, and for the Central San Joaquin Valley during June 8-September 15, 1970.

Auction sales data shown in this report cover the markets of Chicago, New York, Philadelphia, Detroit and Pittsburgh. Terminal market prices are shown for Los Angeles and San Francisco wholesale markets.

All prices shown in this summary, except auction sales, represent the first quoted price or first quoted price range as taken from the daily published market report. Prices in the daily report shown as "mostly", "some", "few" and "occasional" were omitted from this summary, unless otherwise stated.

Preparation of the summary was by Hugh E. Myers, local representative of the Federal-State Market News Service, Fruit and Vegetables, at Sacramento, California.

Data for this summary were generally compiled from the various reports of the Federal-State Market News Service.
