P R E F A C E

Information pertinent to the marketing of the 1972 season California fresh market nectarine crop is summarized in this publication. Shipments, unload distribution, shipping point prices, auction sales, and wholesale market prices are included. These basic statistical records reflect the supply and demand factors that affect the marketing of the nectarine crop.

F.O.B. shipping point prices for the Central and Southern San Joaquin Valley districts were reported during May 15-September 7, 1972.

Auction sales data shown in this report cover the markets of Chicago, New York, Philadelphia, Detroit and Pittsburgh. Terminal market prices are shown for Los Angeles and San Francisco wholesale markets.

All prices shown in this summary, except auction sales, represent the first quoted price or first quoted price range as taken from the daily published market report. Prices in the daily report shown as "mostly", "some", "few" and "occasional" were omitted from this summary, unless otherwise stated.

Preparation of the summary was by Hugh E. Myers, local representative of the Federal-State Market News Service, Fruit and Vegetables, at Sacramento, California.

Data for this summary were generally compiled from the various reports of the Federal-State Market News Service.

We wish to thank all those individuals who have cooperated in making information available for this review.

CARLOT CONVERSION FACTORS: In 1972 the following carlot conversion factors were in effect for converting nectarine truck shipment and unload package movement data to carlot equivalents. For average rail-car loading data, please refer to page 6 of this summary.

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## MARKETING CALIFORNIA NECTARINES

## Summary of 1972 Season

**INTRODUCTION:** Values for California nectarines at major shipping points generally averaged above a year earlier from mid-season and later. Early season prices on the other hand, were mixed but averaged very nearly the same as in 1971, depending on variety and available size. Demand held up remarkably well during 1972 in view of the all-time record size of the crop. Competition for sales with other deciduous fruits was generally lighter than in recent seasons due to the smaller

production of several tree fruits. Total reported movement of nectarines from California was equivalent to 4,891 carlots, well above the 3,763 shipped in 1971. Truck and piggyback vans dominated the modes of transportation for nectarines. Total crop production was estimated at 86,000 tons, up 17,000 tons from 1971. Value was placed at 15.1 million dollars, nearly 4.4 million above a year earlier, and the highest value of record.

**FRESH MOVEMENT:** Fresh market recorded shipments of California nectarines totaled 4,891 cars and carlot equivalents during 1972. This was well above the recorded volume of 3,763 carlots a year earlier and the largest movement of record. Movement by truck dominated all carrier types with 65 percent of the shipments, the largest volume of record. Rail shipment totaled 1,699 cars, well above both a year earlier and the 5-year 1967-71 average. Movement of nectarines by air carrier was very small which it has been for the last several years.

Total reported movement of nectarines from all states amounted to 4,966 cars and carlot equivalents, up 23 percent from 1971, and largest volume of record. Nectarine production for most states other than California fell below the levels of a year ago.

**UNLOAD DISTRIBUTION:** Combined rail, truck and air unloads of California nectarines at major U.S. and Canadian cities totaled 3,425 cars and carlot equivalents. This was well above the 2,660 carlots reported in 1971. Distribution by area compared to a year earlier was up slightly in the east, midwest and south, sharply higher in Canada, and very nearly the same in the west. The east continued as the

principal out-of-state outlet for California nectarines in 1972. Among the out-of-state unload cities, New York led the nation in receiving the largest share of California volume with 589 carlots, followed by Chicago with 228. Although Los Angeles in 1972 was the number two unload city for California nectarines with 498 carlots, volume was off 6 percent from a year earlier.

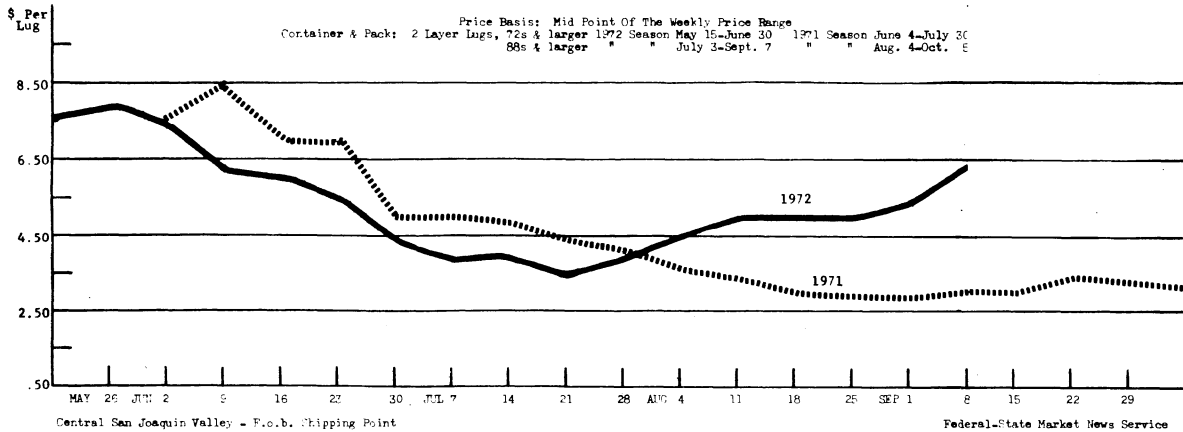
**RAIL CAR LOADING DATA:** The average rail car load of California nectarines was slightly heavier in 1972 than a year earlier. Average net product weight of 2-layer lug container loadings was esti-

mated at 34,200 pounds which was equal to 17.1 tons. Piggyback vans dominated the rail movement with nearly 53 percent of total shipments, up 6 percent from a year ago.

**F.O.B. SHIPPING POINT PRICES:** Sales of California nectarines at shipping point during 1972 generally ranged from about the same to well above a year earlier, especially during the latter part of the

season. Demand for nectarines at major California shipping points held up remarkably well in 1972. This was accomplished despite the all time record size of the 1972 crop.

**EARLY-SEASON PRICES: (May 14-July 1)** Prices for California nectarines at shipping point during early season were mixed but generally averaged very nearly the same as a year ago. Sizes offered early

in the season generally were smaller than last year. Weekly movement during the mid to latter part of the seasonal period was below the same weeks in 1971.

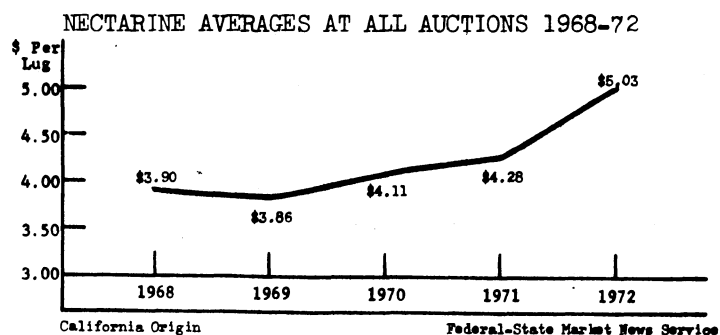
**MID-SEASON PRICES: (July 2-29)** Mid season prices moderated as a result of heavy weekly shipment volume. Prices, however, gen-

erally averaged above the levels of a year ago. Values ranged from 35 to 75 cents above the comparable weeks of 1971.

**LATE-SEASON PRICES: (July 31-Sept. 9)** Values during this period averaged well above 1971 levels. Prices ranged from

a low of \$4.00 to a high of \$6.50 per 2-layer lug. This was \$1.00 to \$3.25 per lug above the same weeks a year ago.

**EASTERN AUCTION MARKETS:** Marketing of California nectarines at eastern auctions dropped to the highest volume in many years. Sales on the other hand, averaged the highest since records were first established. Offerings of California nectarines packed in 2-layer lugs averaged \$5.03 per container, nearly 75 cents above a year earlier. Total volume of all container types expressed in tons was equivalent to 4,141 tons.



**TERMINAL MARKET PRICES:** Wholesale prices at California's two principal markets, namely, Los Angeles and San Francisco, generally averaged above to well above the levels of 1971. Compared to a year

earlier, price extremes were the largest during the latter part of the 1972 season, beginning the week of July 21st and thereafter.

CALIFORNIA rail movement represents shipments at shipping point and includes all districts.

CALIFORNIA truck movement represents shipments recorded at shipping point and represents all districts. For prior years, including 1968-70, shipments included only movement from major districts.

CALIFORNIA air movement represents shipments reported by airlines at San Francisco and Los Angeles airports.

OTHER STATES rail movement represents shipments at shipping point and includes all districts.

OTHER STATES truck figures represent unloads in 41 U.S. cities.

FOREIGN ORIGIN boat and air represents unloads in 41 U.S. cities.

Truck figures are not complete for states other than California but represent the best available information.
