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## P R E F A C E

Information on the marketing of the 1993 season lettuce crops from Salinas-Watsonville and other Central California districts and Colorado is summarized in this publication.

Iceberg lettuce movement is presented on a monthly and weekly basis. Some data are preliminary and subject to revision. Price adjustments made after shipment are not included.

Lettuce movement in this summary is on the following basis; rail shipments - 60,000 pound units (1,200 - 50 pound cartons), rail-truck shipments - 45,000 pound units (900 - 50 pound cartons), and truck shipments - 50,000 pound units (1,000 - 50 pound cartons).

Truck shipments for California, Colorado, New Mexico and New Jersey represent movement recorded at shipping point. Truck shipments for Arizona and Florida are compiled from interstate passing reports. For other states which do not report shipments, data from "Total Arrivals in 22 Cities" were used.

F.o.b. shipping point prices of leaf type and Romaine lettuce from Salinas-Watsonville Districts are included. Wholesale market price ranges are also shown for California lettuce at Los Angeles, New York, Chicago, and Atlanta.

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## NARRATIVE REVIEW OF THE 1993 LETTUCE SEASON, BY DISTRICT

**HIGHLIGHTS:** Harvested acreage for California in 1993 was approximately 141,000 acres compared to 147,000 acres in 1992.

Shipments from California totaled 73,263,500 cartons compared to 78,884,500 cartons in 1992. This was a decrease of 8%. The peak shipping months for 1993 were May and June with 9,888,400 cartons and 9,406,700 cartons respectively.

Shipping point prices ranged from a low of \$3.50-4.10 during June 9-14 in the Salinas-Watsonville District to a high of \$30.00 on April 16 in the Kern District.

### SALINAS-WATSONVILLE

**WEATHER:** Rainfall for the 1993 planting and harvesting season increased 30% from 1992. Rainfall per month was as follows: January 6.45", February 3.37", March 1.97", April .22", May .82", June .27", July 0", August - Trace, September .01", October .12", November .77" and December 1.18". Total rainfall for 1993 was 15.18" as compared with 11.68" for 1992.

**SHIPMENTS:** Shipments for 1993 totaled 44,797,700 cartons (spring 10,576,600, summer 21,392,200 and fall 12,828,900). This was a decrease of 8% from 1992.

There were no rail cars shipped during the 1993 season.

Shipments by rail-truck totaled 3,764,700 cartons (4,183 rail-truck), which accounted for 8% of the total movement. In 1992 the total was 4,354,200 cartons (4,838 rail-truck), which accounted for 9% of the overall movement.

Truck shipments totaled 41,033,000 cartons which accounted for 92% of the total movement. Truck shipments for the 1992 season totaled 44,040,000 cartons which accounted for 91% of the total shipments.

The shipping period for 1993 lasted from April 11 through November 20. The shipping period for 1992 was April 2 through November 20.

**MARKETING:** F.o.b. prices were reported from April 26 through October 29. Prices ranged from a low of \$3.50-4.10 June 9-14 to a high of \$25.00 April 26-27.

### SANTA MARIA-GUADALUPE-LOMPOC

**SHIPMENTS:** Shipments started the week of March 21-27 and ran through the end of the year. Shipments decreased approximately 1%. The 1993 season totaled 8,389,600 cartons (spring 1,798,100, summer 3,753,000, fall 2,838,500).

Shipments by rail-truck totaled 426,600 cartons (474 rail-truck) which accounted for 5% of overall movement. In 1992 there were 514,800 cartons (572 rail-truck) which accounted for 6% of the overall movement.

Truck shipments totaled 7,963,000 cartons which accounted for 95% of overall movement. In 1992 shipments totaled 7,935,000 cartons or 94% of the total.

**MARKETING:** F.o.b. prices were reported from April 13 through November 29. Prices ranged from a low of \$3.50-3.75 June 14-15 to a high of \$25.00-28.00 April 16-20.

**CENTRAL SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY**  
(Firebaugh-Huron-Lost Hills)

**SPRING**

**SHIPMENTS:** Shipments for the 1993 spring season totaled 5,099,300 cartons, a decrease of 11% from the 1992 spring season total of 5,688,700 cartons.

Rail-truck shipments totaled 222,300 cartons (247 rail-truck) which accounted for 4% of the total movement as compared with the 1992 total of 497,700 cartons (553 rail-truck) which accounted for approximately 9% of overall movement.

Truck shipments totaled 4,877,000 cartons which accounted for 92% of overall spring movement. In 1992 shipments totaled 5,186,000 cartons which was 91% of the total movement.

The shipping period for the 1993 spring season was March 21 through May 1.

**MARKETING:** F.o.b. prices were reported from March 29 through April 23 with prices ranging from a low of \$8.00-10.00 March 30-31 to a high of \$25.00 April 16-23.

**FALL**

**SHIPMENTS:** The 1993 fall season shipments totaled 5,265,900 cartons, a decrease of 5% from the 1992 fall season total of 5,508,400 cartons.

Rail-truck shipments totaled 675,900 cartons (751 rail-truck) which accounted for 13% of the total fall shipments. The 1992 total of 455,400 cartons (506 rail-truck) accounted for 8% of overall movement.

Truck shipments totaled 4,590,000 cartons which was 87% of the total fall movement. In 1992 shipments totaled 5,053,000 cartons which accounted for 92% of overall movement.

The shipping period for the 1993 fall season was October 10 through December 11.

**MARKETING:** F.o.b. prices were reported from October 21 through November 24. Prices ranged from \$4.10-5.10 the beginning of the fall season, went as high as \$7.10-8.10 on October 28 and finished the season at \$4.10.

**SOUTHERN SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY**  
(Kern District)

**SPRING**

**SHIPMENTS:** Shipments for the 1993 spring season totaled 557,700 cartons, down 24% from the previous year's total of 814,100 cartons.

Rail-truck shipments totaled 29,700 cartons (33 rail-truck) which accounted for approximately 5% of the total movement. Shipments for 1992 totaled 107,100 cartons (119 rail-truck) or 13% of the total movement.

Truck shipments totaled 628,000 cartons, which accounted for 95% of the total spring movement, compared to 1992's total of 707,000 cartons or 87% of the movement.

The shipping period for the 1993 spring season was March 21 through May 8.

**MARKETING:** F.o.b. prices were reported from March 30 through April 6. Prices opened at \$8.00-9.00. Prices increased to \$10.00 on April 1 and continued to increase throughout the season. The spring season ended with a high of \$27.00-30.00. This was the highest price quoted for 1993.

## **FALL**

**SHIPMENTS:** Shipments for the fall 1993 season totaled 677,100 cartons, down 49% from the previous year's total of 1,330,800 cartons.

Rail-truck shipments totaled 71,100 cartons (79 rail-truck) which accounted for 11% of the total movement. Movement for 1992 was 64,800 cartons (72 rail-truck) or 5% of the total shipments.

Truck shipments totaled 606,000 cartons which accounted for 89% of the total movement. This was a decrease of 49% from the 1992 total truck shipments of 1,266,000 cartons or 95% of the total movement.

The shipping period for the 1993 fall season was October 17 through December 18.

**MARKETING:** There were no f.o.b. shipping point prices reported for the 1993 fall season.

## **COLORADO** (San Luis Valley District)

**ACREAGE:** Approximately 3,600 acres were harvested in the San Luis Valley.

**SHIPMENTS:** A total of 1,475,000 cartons were shipped during the 1993 season as compared with 1,658,000 cartons in 1992. All shipments were by truck.

**MARKETING:** F.o.b. prices were reported from July 26 through September 7, a total of 44 days. F.o.b. prices generally ranged from a low of \$4.00 to a high of \$10.10-11.10 on July 26.
