**FLORIDA SHIPMENTS  
FRESH FRUITS AND VEGETABLES**

**SOURCE OF SHIPMENT DATA:** The U.S.D.A. Fruit and Vegetable Market News Branch in Washington tabulates the rail information from reports which were furnished by the various originating rail lines, and was the source of the rail data. Citrus truck shipments were from the certified records of the Florida Citrus Inspection Service. Vegetable and miscellaneous fruit truck shipments shown here were collected through the help of the Florida Road Guard Inspection Stations at check points strategically located along the St. Mary's River and Suwanee River. Exceptions to the latter collection were avocados and limes which were reported by the Avocado and Lime Administrative Committees; peaches and West Florida tomatoes were collected from shippers by the Thomasville, Georgia market news office; and West Florida watermelons were collected through large weight scales in the area. Citrus gift fruit movement came from the records of the Florida Department of Citrus.

Reported crop year in this publication extends from September 1 through August 31.
