MARKETING LODI TOKAY GRAPES

Summary of the 1962 Season

Despite lower average prices than the previous season, the 1962 Tokay fresh shipping season was generally considered very satisfactory by trade members. Quality was much improved with pack uniformity and sugar-acid ratio aided through the reinstatement of grade regulations. Bunch size was average while color development was greatly accelerated by mild temperatures immediately prior to harvest time. A complete harvest was not realized due to rain during the period October 13-14 which totaled 2.42 of an inch. However, members of the trade estimated less than 100 carlot equivalents of Tokays remained to be harvested for fresh market at that time.

Light harvest began August 20, one day earlier than in 1961. Although the first rail shipment was made on August 27, the majority of shipments during the first week of harvest moved by truck. Shipments during August were moderate, totaling 235 carlot equivalents. The peak shipping week was reached during the period September 9-15 when 670,860 packages were shipped, the highest weekly total since the 1959 season. However, the peak shipping day was not reached until September 18 when 131,011 packages were moved. Distribution to consuming areas was widespread, with preliminary data indicating over 50 percent of the total movement was by truck.

Movement from storage began October 10 as a result of the rain which halted harvesting for fresh market. Cold storage holdings of Tokay grapes on October 1, 1962 were reported to be 278,310 packages. Due to curtailment of harvest for fresh market, these cold storage holdings were absorbed rapidly by the trade. On October 31, cold storage holdings totaled 7,870 packages compared with the five year, 1957-61 average of 98,630 packages.

This season, as in many of the past seasons, the Tokay industry operated under the provisions of the Tokay Marketing Agreement. The TMA, operating under Federal Law, is designed to create orderly marketing through control of quality and quantity of the supply marketed. Although there were no restrictions on quantity of supply marketed, the industry voted to retain the grade regulations in effect during the 1961 season. Also, three additional regulations were voted upon and approved for the season. They were as follows:

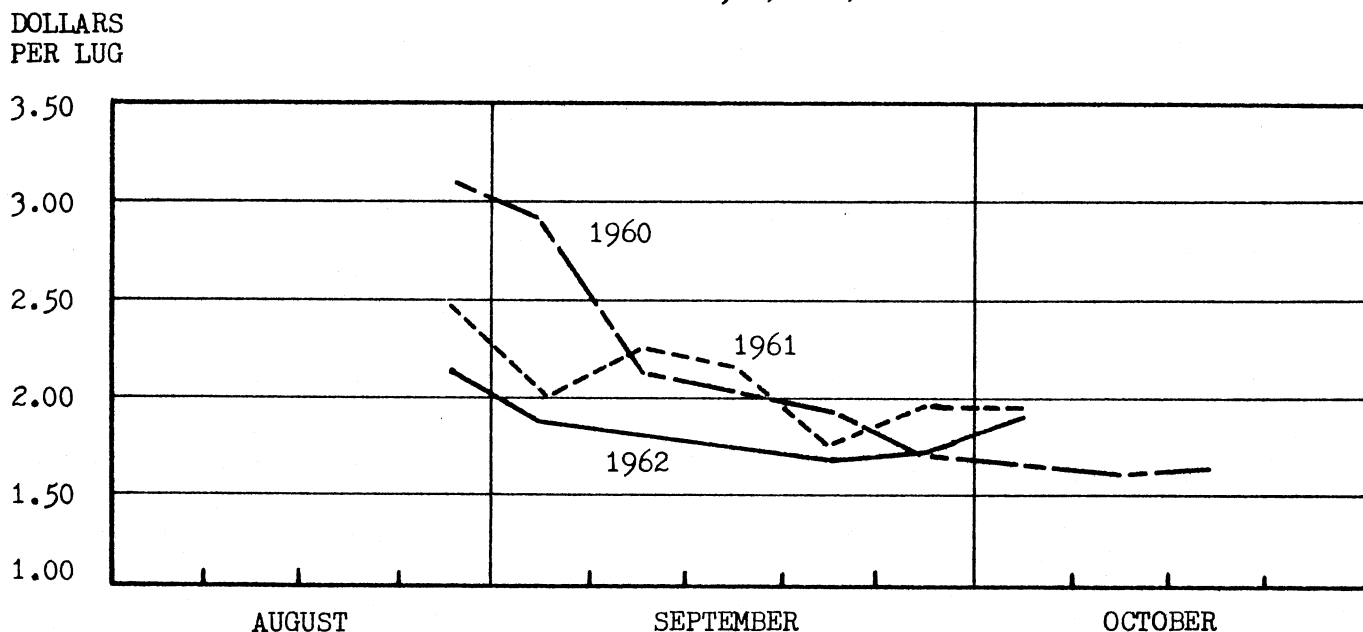
"Sugar-Acid Regulation: Ratio of 23:1 (23 parts sugar to 1 part acid).

No-Repacking Regulation: All Tokay grapes which are packed for fresh shipment which do not meet the Federal-State inspection, based on the regulations in effect, cannot be shipped out of the County of San Joaquin and cannot be further repacked for shipment out of the County of San Joaquin.

Lot Stamping Regulations: Except when loaded directly into railway cars, containers of Tokay grapes shall be plainly stamped prior to shipment with a Federal-State inspection lot stamp number, assigned by such service showing that such Tokay grapes have been inspected in accordance with the established grade set forth by the Department of Agriculture."

Price trends at shipping point during the 1962 season were below those of the previous two seasons. The following graph shows the trends for the past three seasons:

AVERAGE F.O.B. SHIPPING POINT PRICES OF LODI DISTRICT TOKAY GRAPES, BY WEEKS, 1960-1962



Shipping point prices for the 1962 season were first reported on August 27 at \$2.25 per 28 lb. display lug. This was considerably below the 1961 season opening price of \$3.50 per lug. As shipping volume increased, prices gradually declined, and on September 4 the reported market price was \$1.85 per lug under a good demand. During the period September 4 through September 21, a price level of \$1.75-1.85 was maintained, with demand ranging from slow to good. Shipments during this period amounted to about 40 percent of the season's total movement. On September 24 prices reached the season's low of \$1.65-1.75 and remained there through October 4. On October 5, as many growers had finished harvesting for the season, demand again became quite active for the limited offerings. Prices gradually increased from \$1.75 on October 5 to the season's final reported price of \$1.85-2.00 per lug for fresh stock on October 11.

The following table shows general price ranges, packout, and shipments of Tokays, by weeks, during the 1962 season:

Storage stock was first offered to the trade on October 11 at prices ranging from \$2.10-2.25 per lug, storage paid. Trade acceptance was good and prices advanced to \$2.25 per lug during the next few days and remained there until the final storage price report of the season was issued on October 18.

In contrast with last season, a larger percentage of the crop was sold in mid-western and eastern auctions. A total of 113,377 packages sold in the auctions amounted to 3 percent of the entire 1962 pack as compared to 2½ percent of the 1961 pack. The 1962 weighted average price of \$2.88 per lug was 9¢ above the 1961 weighted average price of \$2.79 for Tokays sold at auction.
