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MARKETING WESTERN AND CENTRAL NEW YORK CABBAGE

(Fresh Market and Processing)

1981 CROP

Daily market reports on cabbage were issued from the Rochester Federal-State Market News office from July 22, 1981 through April 21, 1981. The information contained in this summary was obtained from these reports, along with reports from the Transportation Section, Market News Branch, and from releases issued by the USDA's Economics Statistics and Cooperative Service and the New York Crop Reporting Service.

According to the Crop Reporting Board, ESCS, USDA, the 1981 U.S. July-December cabbage crop for fresh market was estimated at 10,376 thousand hundredweight, 617 thousand hundredweight more than the 1980 crop of 9,759 thousand hundredweight. Upstate New York was estimated at 2,340 thousand hundredweight, 58 thousand hundredweight less than the 1980 crop. Upstate New York continued to be the leading producer of fresh market cabbage for the July/December period.

Despite increasing production of cabbage for kraut by 5,790 tons over 1980, New York's total of 89,600 tons was second to Wisconsin's total of 91,700 tons. Total 1981 U.S. cabbage for kraut production was 246,090 tons, up approximately 18 percent over 1980.

Growing conditions for the Summer crop in New York were generally good, although cool wet weather, insect damage and field rot resulted in a wide variation in quality and yield for the storage crop.

The first shipping point market report was issued on July 22. Principal fresh market packs were 50-lb sacks, 1-3/4 bushel crates or cartons. From August through mid-October, prices for large cabbage in sacks ranged from 1.65-2.00 per sack, and for medium in sacks 1.75-2.50. Cabbage prices rose in October and generally leveled off, with occasional rises and declines until mid April. Light supplies and good demand in late April contributed to higher prices.
