1984 CROP

WEATHER AND CROP

As was the case in 1983, cool, wet April 1984 weather delayed most cabbage planting until the end of the month. Wet, cool, and generally unfavorable weather conditions continued through much of May, with heavy rains the last week of May resulting in cabbage growth two to three weeks behind schedule. June was generally favorable for growth, with warmer temperatures and only light rainfall. Hot, dry weather during July and early August resulted in some heat stress, although early planted fields were ready for harvest by mid-August. Through September, weather conditions remained favorable, with minimal head splitting reported as harvest reached its peak. Cutting continued through most of October, with late varieties showing rapid growth as a result of warm fall temperatures.

According to the NYS Crop Reporting Service, 1984 fresh market cabbage production was 3,212,000 cwt, compared to 2,664,000 cwt for 1983. Yield in 1984 was 440 cwt per acre, compared to 370 cwt per acre in 1983. Harvested acreage was relatively stable at 7300 acres.

MARKETING

The first F.O.B. shipping point report was issued on Wednesday, August 1, with prices quoted at \$2.75-3.25 for cartons of medium sized cabbage. Initial offerings of bagged large cabbage were quoted at \$2.50-2.75 per bag. Through October, prices rose only slightly for medium while price for large fell as low as \$1.60. Grower prices were generally at \$40.00 per ton for large, \$50.00 per ton for medium. During November and December, with offerings mostly from storage, prices rose slightly, leveling off in January. Heavy snow, blowing and drifting, and closed roads during the week of January 21 resulted in prices generally tripling and quadrupling. As weather and road conditions returned to normal the following two weeks, prices quickly dropped back to lower levels. Bagged large stabilized at \$4.00-4.50 per bag, with bagged medium at \$4.50-5.00. Prices then generally declined through mid-March. Light supplies from Texas and Florida during the traditionally heavy demand period of late March helped push prices higher through the end of April.

Truck shipments for the 1984-85 season totaled 3674 trucklots (40,000 lbs) compared to 3698 trucklots for the 1983-84 season.

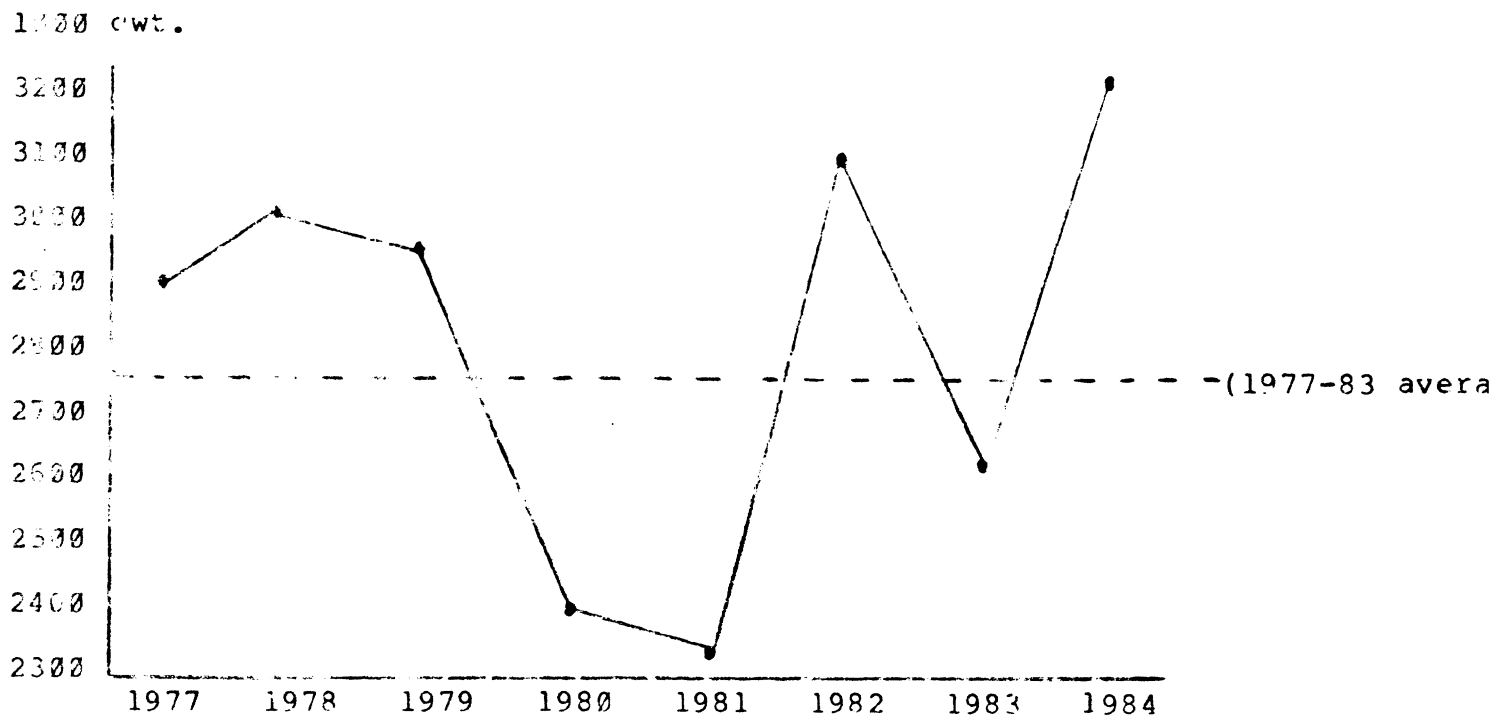

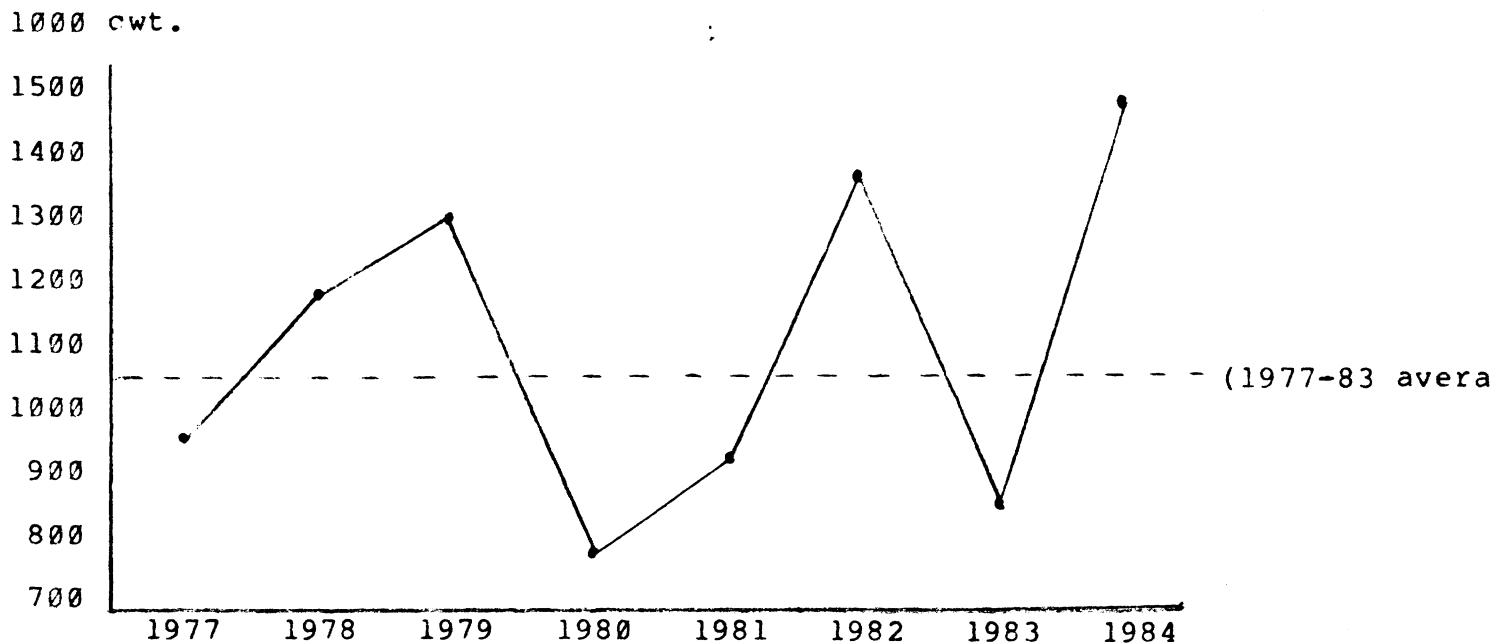
CABBAGE: HARVESTED PRODUCTION - 1977-1984
