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PREFACE

This publication is a marketing summary of the 1993 New York Cabbage crop for the Western and Central New York producing area.

The information contained in this summary was obtained from reports published by the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Federal-State Market News Service, and National Agricultural Statistics Service.

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We wish to express our sincere appreciation to the growers, shippers, brokers, processors and buyers for their cooperation.

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WESTERN AND CENTRAL NEW YORK CABBAGE**1993 CROP****ACREAGE AND PRODUCTION:**

According to the New York Agricultural Statistics Service, 1993 Upstate New York cabbage production totaled 3,318,000 hundredweight, approximately 52 percent more than the 1992 crop, and approximately 17 percent more than the past five year average. Harvested acreage increased to 7900, with yield per acre reported as 420 hundredweight.

Kraut cabbage for processing totaled 73,000 tons from 2000 harvested acres, a yield of 36.50 tons per acre. Kraut cabbage production was approximately 109 percent more than 1992, and approximately 28 percent more than the past five year average.

On January 1, 1993, Upstate cabbage storages held 1,250,000 hundredweight, 24 percent above the previous year, and approximately 2 percent above the past five year average.

MARKETING:

The first F.O.B. Shipping Point report was issued on July 14, with initial quotes for large green cabbage in 50 pound mesh sacks at \$7.00-7.50 per bag. Green medium in 50 pound cartons was first quoted at \$7.50-8.00 per carton. Prices declined steadily through July and August, steadied in September, and reached a seasonal low by mid-October, with large at 2.25-2.50 per bag and cartons at 4.50-5.00. From mid-October through the end of April, prices increased slightly but remained in a fairly narrow range with trading generally sluggish.

SHIPMENTS:

Truck shipments for the 1993-94 season, through the end of April, both in bulk bins and bags or cartons, totaled 4782 truckloads (40,000 lbs), compared to 3785 truckloads for the 1992-93 season, and 4822 truckloads for the 1991-92 season.

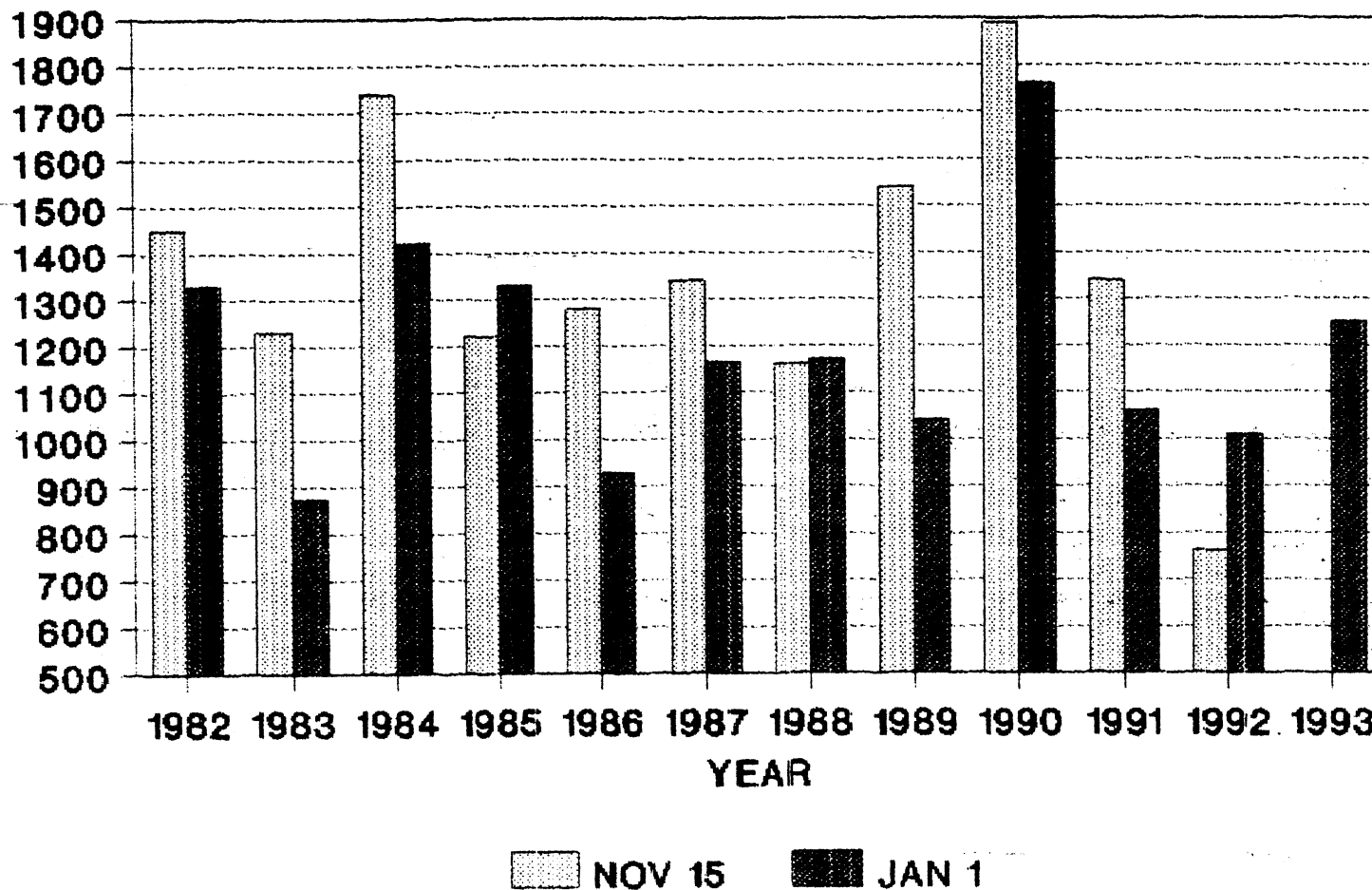
