WESTERN AND CENTRAL NEW YORK POTATOES**1993 CROP****ACREAGE AND PRODUCTION:**

According to the New York Agricultural Statistics Service, Upstate New York potato production for 1993 totaled 5,830,000 hundredweight, an increase of less than 1 percent from the 1992 crop, and an increase of approximately 6 percent from the past five year average. Harvested acreage increased to 22,000 acres, with an average yield per acre of 265 hundredweight.

MARKETING:

The first F.O.B. Shipping Point report was issued on August 16, with U.S. No. 1, size A washed potatoes in 10 lb bags initially quoted at \$1.10-1.15 per bag. 50 lb bags were first quoted at \$5.50-6.00 per bag. Prices declined through early November, with 10 lb bags at their seasonal low of \$.85-1.00. By the end of December, prices had increased to a range of \$1.05-1.10. From mid January through the end of April, a very narrow trading range of \$1.20-1.25 per bag for loose 10's was established.

SHIPMENTS:

Total truck shipments of table stock potatoes for the 1993-94 season, through the end of April, were 2505 truckloads (50,000 lbs.), compared to 1763 truckloads for the 1992-93 season, and 2068 truckloads for the 1991-92 season.

In addition, 3395 truckloads of chip stock potatoes were reported for the 1993-94 season, compared to 3063 truckloads for the 1992-93 season.

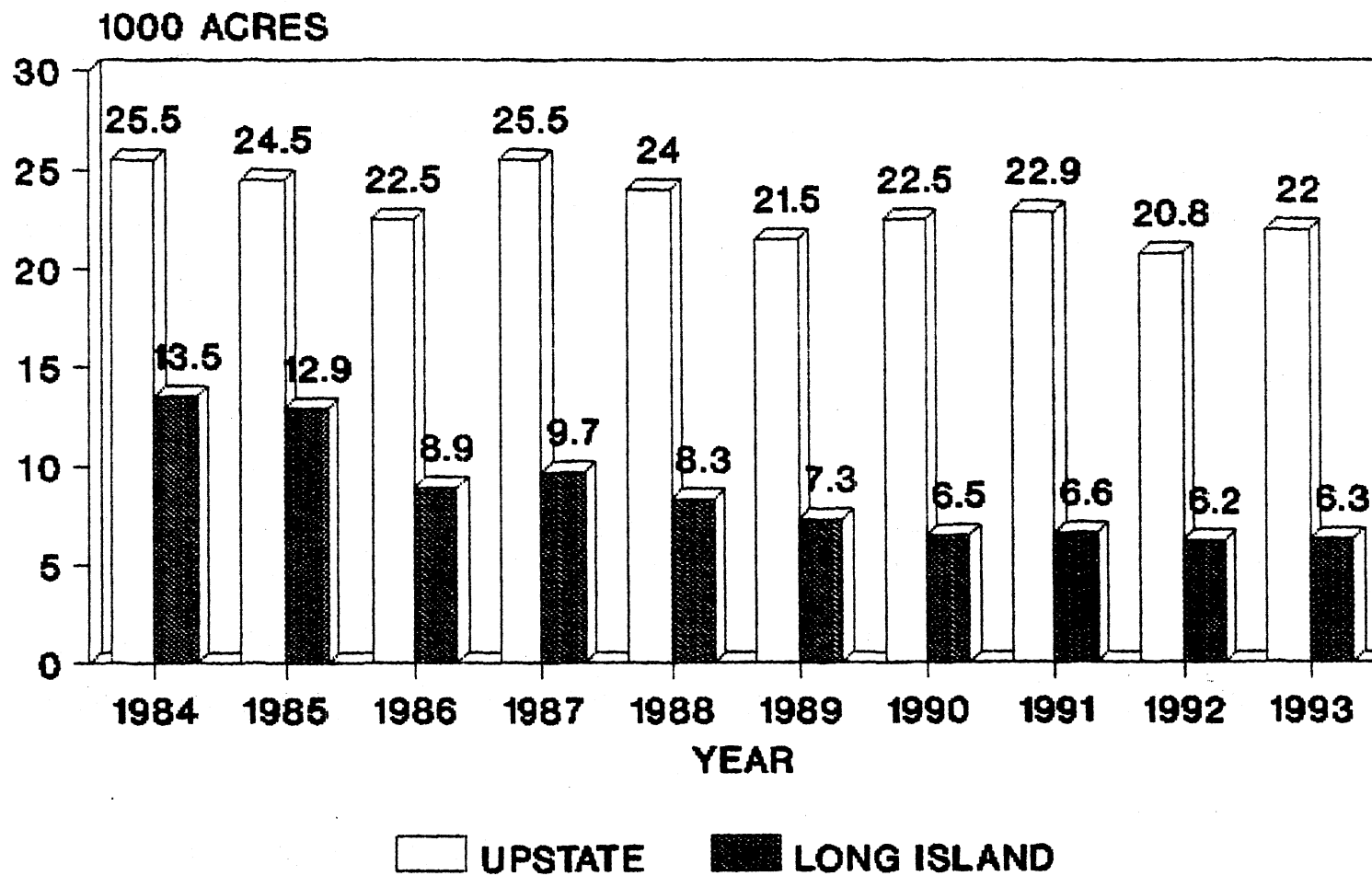

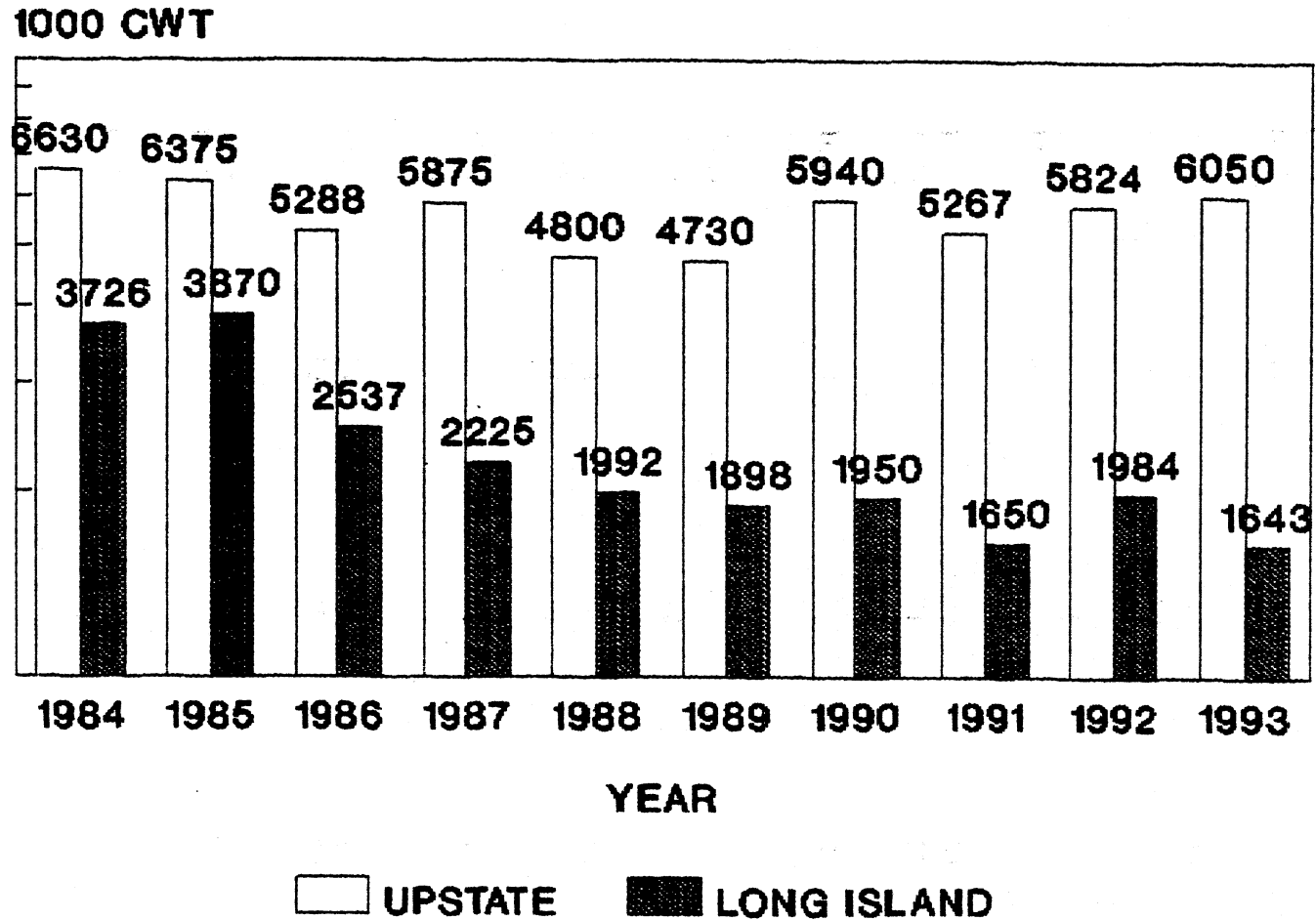
