THE 1982 PEANUT CROP IN REVIEW

PRODUCTION: According to the United States Department of Agriculture Crop Reporting Board, the 1982 peanut crop totaled 3.44 billion pounds (1.56 million metric tons). This represented a 14 percent decrease when compared to the record 3.98 billion pounds (1.81 million metric tons) that was produced in 1981. Most of the decline in production from 1981 was caused by the 14 percent reduction in acres harvested. Acres harvested in 1982 was at 1.27 million acres, the lowest level since 1933. Yields averaged a record high 2696 pounds per acre, 21 pounds above the record set in 1981 when yields averaged 2675 pounds per acre.

In the Southeastern states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, and South Carolina production totaled 2.22 billion pounds, 11 percent below the 1981 crop. Area harvested totaled 712 thousand acres, compared with 869 thousand acres harvested in 1981. Yield per acre registered 3122 pounds, up 258 pounds from the previous year. Production and acres harvested was down in all states.

Virginia and North Carolina production totaled 691 million pounds, down 197 million pounds when compared to the 1981 production of 886 million pounds. Growers harvested 242 thousand acres, 13 percent below the 1981 crop. Yield per acre, at 2854 pounds, was 345 pounds lower than the 1981 yield of 3199 pounds. Acreage, yield, and production was down in both states when compared to the 1981 crop.

Southwestern growers in the states of New Mexico, Oklahoma, and Texas produced 525 million pounds during 1982, 14 percent below the previous year. The lower production resulted from both lower average yields and less acreage harvested. Growers harvested 321 thousand acres compared with 343 thousand acres in 1981. The average yield per acre dropped 138 pounds in 1982 to 1633 pounds.

PLANTING, GROWING, AND HARVESTING: Overall conditions for the 1982 crop were generally good. Growers were generally free of any severe weather problems and delays were not experienced for any great lengths in either planting or harvesting. The generally good growing season was responsible for the record yield that was set in 1982.

As usual the first plantings of the nation's peanut crop came from the Southwestern section. Planting got underway in the south Texas counties of Frio, Wilson, and Atacosa in mid March. Planting was generally complete by early May in South Texas, this area does though represent a low percentage of the nation's crop. The usual planting pattern continued with Central Texas, North Texas, and Oklahoma following suit in mid May. Planting progressed very slowly in May due to consistent rainfall but by mid June growers were actively planting. Planting was generally complete by early July, about three weeks later than usual due to the rainfall received in May. Growing conditions were satisfactory, although in August the majority of the crop was under stress from hot and dry weather. Rains in late August provided relief. September was also mostly a dry month but spotty rains throughout the month kept the crop in reasonable condition. Very light harvesting began in South Texas in early August but was slow due to the hot and dry weather. Harvesting was complete there by early October. Harvest in Central Texas, North Texas, and Oklahoma began in a very light way in mid October. Harvest gained momentum in November, Oklahoma's crop was completed by mid November while Texas was complete by late November. There was a small percentage of freeze damage, which affected the crop that was harvested in late November.

Planting in the Southeastern Section began in mid April but did not become active until early May when much needed rainfall was received. The ample moisture stimulated planting and the area was generally complete by late May. Growing conditions were very good as more than ample amounts of rainfall were received in June and July. There was even some concern that the continuous rainfall could cause white mold and weed problems. Harvesting began in Florida in mid August, followed by Georgia and Alabama in early September. By mid September harvest was in full swing and was generally complete by early October.

Very light planting in the Virginia-North Carolina Section began in late April. Planting increased sharply in early May when warm temperatures moved into the area for the first time. The majority of the crop was planted by late May. Rainfall was abundant for the entire growing season and at times caused concern to growers. Harvesting began in a light way in late September but remained light until mid October due to consistent rainfall. Harvesting actively got underway and was generally complete by late October. A freeze, followed by a severe storm in late October affected a small percentage of the crop. Overall, the crop was harvested without any major problems.

THE 1982 PEANUT CROP IN REVIEW CONTINUED

MARKETING: Sales on the 1982 crop were mostly higher when compared to the prices that were received for the 1981 crop. The most notable exception was for all grades of Southwestern spanish type peanuts, which were sharply lower. Inshell grades of Virginia type peanuts was also an exception although prices were higher than the 1981 crop until February. The month of February began a sharp downward trend, prices did though rally at the end of the season. Preharvest contracts were not prevalent until July, although some grades did trade as early as March.

Prices received in the Southeastern section for the 1982 crop were higher on all grades when compared to the prices of the 1981 crop. The one exception was the jumbos when prices dipped lower in May when compared to 1981. Medium and No. 1's were higher all season and U.S. Splits slightly higher in comparison to the 1981 prices. The 14/16 size peanuts were sharply higher in 1982, anywhere from fifteen to twenty cents, according to the month. Preseason contract trading did not become active until July, trading for the crop became very active in September when harvest got into full swing. Spot prices for prompt delivery recorded in September were 47 3/4 on jumbos, 48 7/8 on medium, 45 1/2 on No. 1's, 47 5/8 on U.S. Splits, and 31 1/2 on 14/16 size. Prices showed a slightly downward trend on most sizes for the remainder of the season. In July, when most sales were finished, prices recorded were: jumbos 46 3/4, medium 46 1/2, No. 1's 46, and U.S. Splits 46. As mentioned earlier, the exception to the downward trend in prices was on the 14/16 size. After the 31 1/2 price that was recorded in September, the price jumped the following month to 38 7/8. Prices showed an upward trend for the remainder of the season, with closing prices in July being at 42 1/2.

Prices received in the Virginia-North Carolina section for the 1982 crop were mostly higher when compared to the prices recorded for the 1981 crop. Preseason contract trading was noted as early as July but did not become active until September. Trading for the crop became very active in October, when harvesting got into full swing. Spot prices for prompt delivery recorded in October were 48 1/8 on jumbos, 46 3/4 on fancy, 52 on extra large, 48 1/2 on medium, 46 3/4 on No. 1's, and 45 3/8 on No. 2's. Prices for both inshell jumbo and fancy showed a downward trend in price until April. Prices recorded in April for jumbo were 40 1/4 and on fancy, 39. In May the market reversed itself and prices finished stronger for the remainder of the season. Closing prices for the inshell grades were 44 on jumbos and 41 1/8 on fancy. Prices for shelled grades also showed a downward trend in price but not until the month of July did the market reverse itself. Prices recorded for the month of June on shelled grades were 47 1/8 on extra large, 46 3/4 on medium, 46 1/4 on No. 1's, and 45 7/8 on No. 2's. Closing prices for the crop were 51 3/4 on extra large, 49 on medium, and 46 1/2 on No. 2's.

In the Southwestern section, trading got underway for both spanish and runner types in August and October for the valencia type. Shelled spanish type jumbos started at 54, No. 1's also at 54, and U.S. Splits at 49. Prices showed a very slight downward trend until the month of July, when the market reversed itself and finished strong. Closing prices were jumbos 56, No. 1's 54, and U.S. Splits 46 3/4. Shelled runner type jumbos started at 50 3/4, medium at 49, and U.S. Splits at 48 5/8. Runner prices started a downward trend shortly after its initial debut and continued that pattern for the remainder of the season. Closing prices were 47 for both jumbo and medium, and 46 7/8 for U.S. Splits. The valencia crop, grown in New Mexico, started at 44 1/2 and finished in May at 43 1/2.

The 1982 crop average support price to growers was set at \$550 for quota peanuts and \$200 for additional peanuts. For comparison the 1981 crop average support price was \$450 for quota and \$250 for additional.
