THE 1983 PEANUT CROP IN REVIEW

PRODUCTION: According to the United States Department of Agriculture Crop Reporting Board, the 1983 peanut crop totaled 3.30 billion pounds (1.49 million metric tons). This represented a 4 percent decrease when compared to the 3.44 billion pounds (1.56 million metric tons) that was produced in 1982 and 17 percent below the record high 3.98 billion pounds (1.81 million metric tons) produced in 1981. The decline in production from 1982 was caused by a reduction in acreage in the Southwest and lower average yields in the Southeast and in the Virginia-North Carolina area. Growers planted 1.41 million acres (571 thousand hectares) in 1983, while 1.37 million acres (556 thousand hectares) were harvested in 1982. This represents an increase of 8 percent in both planted and harvested acres from 1982. Yields averaged 2399 pounds per acre, sharply lower than the record high 2696 pounds per acre produced in 1982.

In the Southeastern states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, and South Carolina production totaled 2.21 billion pounds, down slightly from the 1982 total of 2.22 billion pounds. Increased acres harvested was not enough to offset the decline in average yields. Growers harvested 815 thousand acres, a 14 percent increase above the previous year total of 712 thousand acres. Yield per acre at 2719 pounds was 403 pounds below the 1982 amount of 3122 pounds. Yield per acre in all states was down from 1982 but planted and harvested acreage was up.

Virginia and North Carolina production totaled 517 million pounds, a 25 percent reduction from the 1982 output of 691 million pounds. Growers planted and harvested 246 and 242 thousand acres, respectively, the same levels a year earlier. Yield and production were down in both states for the second consecutive year.

Southwestern growers in the states of New Mexico, Oklahoma, and Texas produced 564 million pounds during 1983 compared with 525 million pounds in 1982. The increased production resulted with acreage increases in New Mexico and Oklahoma and improved yields in Texas. Growers harvested 317 thousand acres, 4.4 thousand acres below the previous year. The average yield per acre was up 148 pounds in 1983 when yields averaged 1781 pounds.

PLANTING, GROWING, AND HARVESTING: Overall conditions for the 1983 crop were generally poor. Planting got off to a very slow start. Early plantings in South Texas was delayed by wet and at times near freezing temperatures. In the Southeast and Virginia-North Carolina section, continuous rain and wet fields delayed both preparatory field work and planting. Hot and dry conditions persisted throughout most of the summer months in all three growing areas. Temperatures were above normal and rainfall was well below average. Temperatures in July and August were extremely high and to the point of setting records in some areas. As a result, harvesting got off to a late start and was hampered later on by inclement weather.

As usual the first plantings of the nation's peanut crop gets underway in the Southwestern section. Planting in the South Texas counties of Atacosa, Frio, and Wilson began in mid March. Planting progressed slowly due to cool and wet weather conditions. Planting was generally complete by early May but this area contains only a very small percentage of the nation's crop. The usual planting pattern continued with Central Texas, North Texas, and Oklahoma following suit in mid May. Planting progress was slower than normal due to dry conditions. Heavy rainfall in early June stimulated planting in the entire production area. Planting continued at an active pace for the remainder of the month and was generally complete by the month's end. Growing conditions were generally satisfactory. The majority of the crop was under stress in the summer from hot and dry weather. Periodic rains, however, provided relief throughout the summer. Very light harvesting occurred in South Texas in mid August but progressed slowly due to the hot and dry weather. Harvesting was generally completed there by early October. Harvest in Central Texas, North Texas, and Oklahoma began in a very light way in mid October. Harvesting progressed very slowly for the remainder of the month but gained momentum in early November. Oklahoma's crop was completed by late November while Texas was completed by early December. The New Mexico crop progressed the slowest. Consistent, heavy rainfall delayed the harvest and discoloration of the Valencia crop was widespread. Harvesting was complete in late November about three weeks later than usual.

Planting in the Southeastern section began in mid April but was hampered throughout the month by both cool, wet weather. Planting became active in early May as favorable weather finally entered into the growing area. Excellent weather continued to prevail during the month and planting was generally complete by the end of the month. Growing conditions were very good going into mid July but the crop took a drastic turnaround when hot and dry weather became the norm in late July and August. Light harvesting in Florida and South Georgia began in mid August. It was not until mid September that harvesting gained any significant momentum. After ample rainfall was received planting became active and was generally complete by late October.

PLANTING, GROWING, AND HARVESTING: (Continued) Very light planting in the Virginia-North Carolina section began in late April. Planting increased sharply in early May when warm and dry weather moved into the area for the first time. The majority of the crop was planted by late May. Weather conditions during the growing season were much the same as the Southeastern section when hot and dry weather was the norm. Harvesting began in a very light way in late September but remained light until late October due to consistent rainfall. The poor progress grew concern among the industry as by late October the crop should be close to its completion. Cold, damaging weather generally begins in early November and growers always hope to have harvest complete by then. Freezing temperatures over the weekend of November 4 proved detrimental. The early November freeze caused the remaining unharvested acreage to be abandoned. According to the U.S.D.A. Crop Reporting Service, harvesting was still about 10 percent from its completion in Virginia and about 23 percent in North Carolina when the freeze arrived in the production area. As mentioned earlier there was a 25 percent reduction in yield from the 1982 output, this freeze was responsible for much of the reduction.

MARKETING: The 1983 crop average support price to growers was set at \$550 per short ton for quota peanuts while additional peanuts was set at \$185. The support price on quota peanuts was unchanged from the 1982 crop but additional peanuts were down \$15 from the 1982 crop support price of \$200.

Prices on the 1983 crop were higher when compared to the prices that were received for the 1982 crop. The most notable example was on all grades of Virginia type peanuts, which were sharply higher. Prices for Southeastern and Southwestern grades were also higher, although during the months of December thru March a downward trend was noted. Prices were higher during those months when compared to the 1982 levels and prices rallied strongly in April continuing until early July. Prices then showed a sharp downward trend for the remainder of the season.

In the Southeastern section, preseason contract trading was made as early as January. Trading was sporadic though as most shellers remained off the market during the hot and dry growing season. Trading for the crop did not become active until late October, when inventory levels were finally established. Spot prices recorded in late October for prompt delivery were 63 1/2 on Jumbos, 57 1/2 on Medium, 53 1/2 on No. 1's, 54 1/4 on U.S. Splits and 46 3/4 on 14/16 size. Prices shortly afterwards showed a slight downward trend continuing through the month of March. Prices then showed an upward trend continuing into early July. Very light supplies were sold until late September. Prices were at its highest levels in mid June. Seasonal high prices were 72 on Jumbos, 67 on Medium, 64 1/2 on No. 1's, 65 on U.S. Splits, and 50 1/4 on 14/16 size.

In the Virginia-North Carolina section, preseason contract trading was inactive as shellers were off the market due to the hot and dry growing season. Trading for the crop first began in November. Spot prices for prompt delivery in November were 60 1/8 on Inshell Jumbo and 56 3/8 on Inshell Fancy. Prices on shelled grades were too few to quote as supplies were very light. Nearly all shellers were withdrawn from the market, attempting to fulfill existing contracts. It was believed that prices for inshelled grades in November were roughly 75 on Extra large, 64 on Medium, 54 on No. 1's, and 52 on No. 2's. Prices on inshell grades remained at these high levels for the remainder of the season, with the highest being recorded in February when Jumbos averaged 74 1/2 and fancies averaged 71 5/8. Light supplies of shelled grades were traded mostly in the month of March. Prices during that month averaged 71 3/4 on Extra large, 60 on Medium, 50 3/8 on No. 1's, and 49 3/4 on No. 2's.

In the Southwestern section, preseason contract trading was made as early as March. Active trading on preseason contracts was first noted in June. Spot prices for prompt delivery was however delayed until November, due to the uncertainty of the size of the crop in the competing growing areas. Prices recorded in November for Spanish type peanuts were 59 on Jumbos, 57 on No. 1's, and 53 1/2 on U.S. Splits. Runner prices were 59 on Jumbos, 54 1/4 on Medium and 53 1/2 on U.S. Splits. Prices shortly afterwards showed a slight downward trend continuing through the month of March. Prices then showed an upward trend continuing into early July. Very light supplies were sold until late August. Prices were at its highest levels in early July. Seasonal high prices for the crop on Spanish type were 71 1/2 on Jumbos, 72 on No. 1's and 66 on U.S. Splits. Runner type seasonal high prices were 72 on Jumbos, 55 1/2 on Medium, and 66 on U.S. Splits. The Valencia crop, grown in New Mexico, started in November at 51 1/2 and finishing in May at 54 1/2.
