THE 1985 PEANUT CROP IN REVIEW

PRODUCTION: According to the United States Department of Agriculture, Agricultural Statistics Board, production in 1985 totaled 4.12 billion pounds (1.87 million metric tons), 6 percent below the 1984 record high crop but 25 percent above the 1983 crop. Growers planted 1.49 million acres (603 thousand hectares) and harvested 1.47 million acres (594 thousand hectares). This represents a 5 percent decrease in planted area from 1984 and a 4 percent decline in harvested area. Yield averaged 2810 pounds per acre compared with the record high of 2878 pounds per acre set in 1984.

Production in the southeastern states (Alabama, Florida, Georgia, and South Carolina) totaled 2.76 billion pounds compared with 3.09 billion pounds in 1984--an 11 percent decline. Both planted and harvested area dropped 8 percent from 1984. Average yield per acre was down in all states except South Carolina, where a 150 pound gain was posted.

Virginia and North Carolina production totaled 736 million pounds, 2 percent above the 1984 production for the region. Area planted and harvested was down 2 percent and 1 percent, respectively. Average yield per acre was 2935 pounds in North Carolina and 2955 pounds in Virginia.

Southwestern growers (New Mexico, Oklahoma, and Texas) produced 626 million pounds in 1985, 6 percent above 1984. Planted and harvested area was up 2 percent and 4 percent, respectively. Average yield per acre was above 1984 in New Mexico and Texas, but fell below the 1984 level in Oklahoma.

PLANTING, GROWING, AND HARVESTING: Overall conditions for the 1985 crop were generally good. Growers were generally free of severe weather problems and delays were not experienced in any great lengths in either planting or harvesting.

As usual the first plantings of the nation's peanut crop began in the Southwestern section. Planting in the South Texas counties of Atacosa, Frio, and Wilson got underway in mid March. Planting was mostly complete by mid April but continued into early May. This area contains only a very small percentage of the nation's crop. The usual planting pattern continued with Central Texas, North Texas, Oklahoma, and New Mexico following suit beginning in early May. Planting progress was hampered most of the month due to wet weather. Active planting began in most areas by late May and was generally complete by mid June. Growing conditions were generally satisfactory. Very light harvesting occurred in South Texas in mid July, Central Texas in late August, North Texas, New Mexico, and Oklahoma in mid September. Harvesting progressed very slowly in September due to hot, dry weather. The month of October was extremely wet which further delayed the harvest in all production areas. Clear, dry weather in New Mexico finally became common in early November and growers were complete with their harvest operations shortly afterwards. Harvest operations in Oklahoma and Texas continued at below seasonal levels during most of November. The final stages of the harvest was completed in early December.

Planting in the Southeastern section began in mid April but progressed slowly due to low soil moisture levels. Planting became very active in early May following a heavy rainfall. Excellent weather followed and continued into mid May. The majority of the crop was planted by mid May and planting was generally complete by late May. Growing conditions during June, July, and early August were favorable. Light harvesting in Florida and South Georgia began in late August. Harvest operations reached significant levels by mid September. The harvest then proceeded without any significant delays and was generally complete by mid October.

PLANTING, GROWING, AND HARVESTING: (Continued) Very light planting in the Virginia-North Carolina Section began in early May. Planting increased in mid May following a heavy rainfall and increased sharply soon afterwards when warm, dry weather moved into the area. Planting was virtually complete by the third week of the month. Weather conditions during the growing season were much the same as experienced in the Southeastern section, as a result the crop was mostly in good condition entering harvest time. Harvesting began in a very light way in early September on early Virginia type varieties. Initial harvesting of florigiants got underway in late September. Harvesting was active in October but was hampered several times due to rainfall. The harvest was complete by the end of the month.

MARKETING: The 1985 peanut crop average support price to growers was set at \$559 per short ton for quota peanuts, up \$9 per ton from the 1984 level of \$550 per ton. Additional peanuts were down \$37 per ton at the rate of \$148 per ton compared to the 1984 support level of \$185 per ton.

Shipping point prices on 1985 crop peanuts were mostly higher when compared to prices that were received during the 1984 marketing season. The most notable exception was on grades of whole kernel spanish type peanuts from the southwest which were lower throughout most of the season.

In the southeastern section preseason contract trading was made as early as April. Trading was sporadic throughout the preharvest months primarily due to ample supplies of 1984 old crop remaining to be marketed. The majority of the preseason contract trading was with the stipulation of sellers option of delivery of either old crop peanuts or new crop peanuts. Spot prices for prompt delivery recorded in October, when inventory levels were established, averaged 47 3/4 on Jumbo, 47 1/2 on Medium, 44 on No. 1, 46 on U.S. Splits, and 35 on 14/16 size. Prices showed an upward trend in price through the season. The months of June, July, and August showed significant price increases.

In the Virginia-North Carolina section, preseason contract trading was very light due to the overall national supply level of 1984 old crop remaining to be marketed. Occasional contracts were transacted with the sellers option of delivery of either old crop peanuts or new crop peanuts. Spot prices for prompt delivery in October averaged 40 on Inshell Jumbo and 38 1/4 on Inshell Fancy. Prices on shelled grades were 48 1/8 on Extra Large, 46 1/4 on Medium, 43 7/8 on No. 1, and 42 on No. 2. Prices showed mostly an upward trend throughout the season on Inshell grades while shelled grades tended higher throughout the season.

In the Southwestern section, preseason contract trading was made as early as April. Trading was very light with the majority of the limited transactions containing the sellers option of delivery of either old crop peanuts or new crop peanuts. Spot prices for prompt delivery in October for Spanish type peanuts averaged 51 1/4 on Jumbo and 50 for No. 1. Prices showed an upward trend in price throughout the season. The months of June, July, and August showed significant price increases. Spot runner prices for prompt delivery showed mostly the same marketing pattern as Southeastern runners. The Valencia crop, grown in New Mexico, opened in October averaging 40, finishing in June averaging 39.
