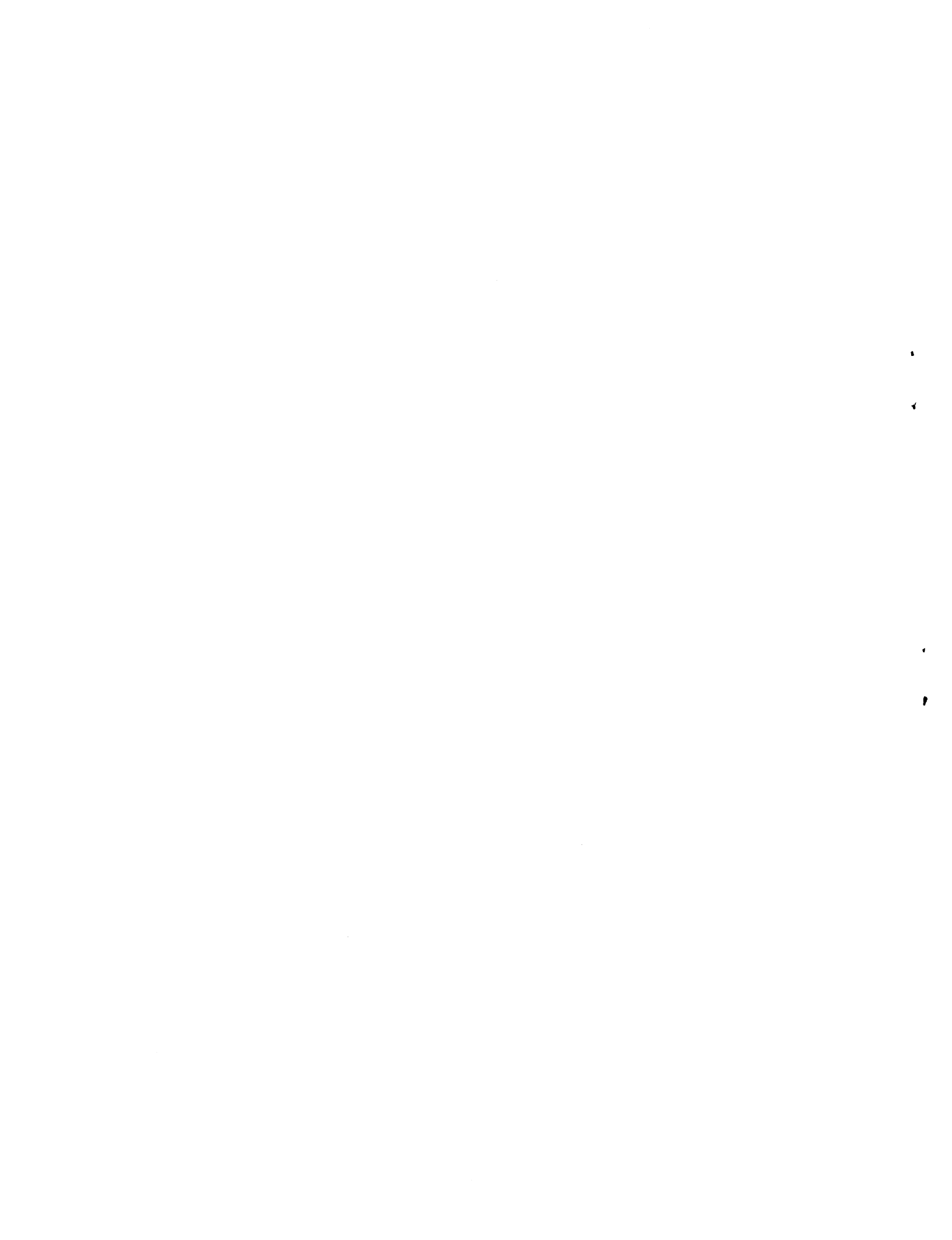

THE 1999 PEANUT CROP IN REVIEW

PRODUCTION: According to the United States Department of Agriculture, Agricultural Statistics Board, United States peanut production in 1999 totaled 3.83 billion pounds, down 3 percent from the 1998 crop and down 1 percent from the January estimate. Planted area totaled 1.53 million acres, up 1 percent from 1998. Harvested acreage totaled 1.44 million acres, a decrease of 2 percent from 1998. The U.S. yield per harvested acre averaged 2,667 pounds, down 35 pounds from 1998.

Production in the Southeastern States (Alabama, Florida, Georgia, and South Carolina) totaled 2.13 billion pounds, down 3 percent from 1998. Yield in the 4-State area averaged 2,497 pounds, down 143 pounds from a year earlier. Georgia remained the leading peanut producer with 37 percent of the total U.S. peanut production.

Virginia and North Carolina growers produced 517 million pounds of peanuts in 1999, down 16 percent from 1998. Yields averaged 2,585 pounds, 515 pounds below 1998.

The Southwest crop (New Mexico, Oklahoma, and Texas) totaled 1.18 billion pounds, 3 percent above the 1998 total. Texas production and yield were the largest on record. Area harvested in the 3-State area down 12 percent from a year ago. Yields averaged 3,092 pounds per acre, 454 pounds above the 1998 average.

PLANTING, GROWING, AND HARVESTING: Planting in the southeastern states began in early April but progressed very slowly for the majority of the month due to dry weather conditions and cooler than normal temperatures. In May, planting activities increased. The majority of the crop was planted the last three weeks of May. Mostly favorable weather conditions were received during the growing season prior to harvest although in South Carolina, during the critical summer months, hot, dry conditions reduced crop prospects. Harvesting began in early September in Florida and Georgia. The harvest made strong advances during September and by early October the harvest was well along. The remaining portion of the crop dragged on into late October receiving numerous harvesting delays due to wet weather.

In the Virginia-North Carolina Section, planting began in late April. By the second week of May the planting of the crop was in full swing. At the end of the month, planting in Virginia was complete while North Carolina plantings were 90 percent complete. Mostly favorable weather conditions were received during the season prior to harvest activities. The yield potential in the production area resulted in a significant decrease due to heavy rainfall from Hurricane Floyd in mid September. Harvesting was at a standstill until early October. By the second week of October the harvest was in full swing. The harvest neared completion in Virginia at the end of October. The North Carolina harvest was considered complete during Thanksgiving week. During November some production losses occurred from cold damaging temperatures.

The Southwestern crop notes the nation's earliest plantings each year when the fields in South Central Texas begins with planting activities. During the week of April 5-11, planting began in this area. During the next two weeks planting was active in this production area which contains only a small percentage of the national crop. The usual planting pattern continued with other production areas in Texas and Oklahoma following between the period of late April to early May. At the end of May about three-fourths of the crop was planted in Oklahoma and two-thirds in Texas. By early June the Oklahoma crop was planted. The remaining portion of the Texas crop dragged on well into June. Growing conditions in the southwest prior to harvest was generally considered favorable across the region. As a matter of record, Texas production and yield were the largest on record.

PLANTING, GROWING, AND HARVESTING(Continued) On August 28, the harvest had begun in Texas on the earliest fields. Prior to mid September the harvest was very slow and had been noted in a few locations in the entire production district. At the beginning of October, the harvest completion rate, production wide, was considered to be one-fourth complete. At the first of November, less than one-fourth of the harvest remained in Oklahoma and less than one-third in Texas. The Oklahoma harvest was considered complete by November 15. The Texas harvest was considered complete by Thanksgiving.

MARKETING: The 1999 peanut crop average support price to growers for quota peanuts was \$610.00 per short ton. This level is mandated for marketing years 1996 through 2002 by the Federal Agriculture Improvement and Reform Act of 1996. Additional peanuts, those marketed in a quantity greater than a farms quota was \$175.00 per short ton, the same as the 1998 crop.

In the Southeastern section, shipping point sales of domestic (quota) peanuts were transacted as early as February 1999. These preseason contract sales were noted on an irregular basis throughout the remaining months prior to harvest. Opening prices on Runner type for prompt delivery (shipments within thirty days) at or near harvest time averaged 60 cents on Jumbo, 58 cents on Medium, 54 cents on No. 1 and 56 cents on U.S. Splits. The highest price levels recorded averaged 63 cents on Jumbo, 58 1/2 cents on Medium, 56 1/2 cents on No. 1, and 58 cents on U.S. Splits. The lowest price levels recorded averaged 59 1/2 cents on Jumbo, 57 cents on Medium, 53 cents on No. 1, and 55 cents on U.S. Splits.

In the Virginia-North Carolina section, preseason contract trading of domestic (quota) peanuts was first noted in March 1999 and continued on an irregular basis throughout the remaining months prior to harvest. Opening prices on Virginia type for prompt delivery at or near harvest time on inshell peanuts averaged 54 cents on Jumbo and 49 1/2 cents on Fancy. Prices on shelled grades averaged 70 cents on Extra Large, 61 cents on Medium, 54 cents on No. 1, and 53 cents on No. 2. The highest price levels recorded averaged 56 1/2 cents on inshell Jumbo, 50 cents on inshell Fancy, 70 cents on Extra Large, 62 cents on Medium, 55 cents on No. 1, and 56 cents on No. 2. The lowest price levels averaged 54 cents on inshell Jumbo, 48 cents on inshell Fancy, 65 cents on Extra Large, 60 cents on Medium, 53 cents on No. 1, and 51 1/2 cents on No. 2.

In the Southwestern section, preseason contract trading of domestic (quota) peanuts were transacted as early as February 1999 and continued on an irregular basis throughout the remaining months prior to harvest. Opening prices on Spanish type for prompt delivery averaged 69 cents on Jumbo, 65 1/2 cents on No. 1, and 56 1/2 cents on U.S. Splits. The highest price levels recorded averaged 83 cents on Jumbo, 80 cents on No. 1, and 58 cents on U.S. Splits. The lowest price levels recorded were noted at or near harvest time. These prices were previously noted. Runner type prices for prompt delivery showed mostly the same price levels as Southeastern runners.
