

## W E S T E R N      C I T R U S      S U M M A R Y

1986—1987 SEASON

### F o r e w o r d

Market reports on citrus fruits were issued twice weekly from the Los Angeles office of the Federal-state Market News Service during the 1986-87 season. This summary was derived from these reports and from reports released by the U. S. Department of Agriculture, Washington, D. C.; the California Crop and Livestock Reporting Service, Sacramento, California; and the Orange and Lemon Administrative Committees, Los Angeles, California.

**F. o. b. prices shown in this summary are weekly price ranges.**

Shipments, arrivals and other similar data for the 1986-1987 season are considered final and represent the citrus crop season from the first of November 1986 to the end of October 1987 except lemons which are from the first of August 1986 to the end of July 1987.

O R A N G E S  
1986 - 1987 CROP YEAR  
UNITED STATES PRODUCTION

Total utilized orange production in the U.S. for the 1986-1987 crop was estimated by the Agricultural Statistics Board, N.A.S.S. of the U.S.D.A. at 181.18 million field boxes \*. This was an increase of 3 percent over the 1985-1986 crop of 175.71 million boxes and almost 12 percent over the 1984-1985 crop of 158.75. Valencias comprised 43.8 percent of the total orange crop for the 1986-1987 year with an estimated 79.38 million boxes. Navel \*\* were put at 101.8 million boxes or 56.2 percent of production. The Texas orange crop was put at only .375 million boxes; still sharply reduced from the December 1983 freeze. Oranges in Florida for 1986-1987 were estimated at 119.7 million boxes as compared to the 1985-1986 crop of 119.2 and the 1984 - 1985 crop of 103.9.

The California orange crop represented 32 percent of the total U.S. production of oranges for the 1986 - 1987 crop year. The California oranges totaled 57.9 million boxes with 23.4 million for Valencias and 34.5 for Navel. California Valencias were about 29 percent of the U.S. crop of Valencias and the California Navel were some 34 percent of total Navel Oranges. The orange production in California was up 7 percent from the 53.9 million boxes of the 1985-1986 crop and 10 percent up from the 1984-1985 crop of 52.4. Arizona orange production was estimated at 2.7 as compared to 2.3 million boxes in 1985-1986 and 2.45 for 1984-1985. This was an increase of 15 percent and 10 percent respectively.

## N A V E L   O R A N G E S

### CALIFORNIA/ARIZONA

The Agricultural Statistics Board estimated the 1986-1987 Navel orange production in California at 34.5 million field boxes\*. This was an increase of nearly 5 percent over the 1985-1986 crop of 33.0 million boxes and 34 percent over the 1984-1985 crop of 22.6. The five year average for California Navels over the 1982-1983 crop through the 1986-1987 was 33.52 million boxes. The largest crop in the period was the 40.2 in 1982-1983 and the smallest was the 26.2 in 1984-1985. Arizona production of Navel oranges was 1.0 million boxes compared to .6 in 1985-1986 and .65 in 1984-1985.

The acreage of bearing Navel orange in California declined to 106,000 acres compared to the 107,000 acres in 1985-1986 and compared with the 108,000 acres in 1984-1985. There were 109,000 acres estimated for the 1983-1984 crop year. Arizona acreage of Navels was put at 4,300 acres for 1986-1987, 4,200 in 1985-1986, and 4,200 for 1984-1985. Yield per acre for California was 651 cartons \*\*\* per acre for the 1986-1987 season and 617 in 1985-1986 and 485 in 1984-1985. Arizona yield was 266 cartons and was 241 in 1984-1985. The yield for the 1984-1985 crop year was only 241 carton per acre.

V A L E N C I A   O R A N G E S

CALIFORNIA/ARIZONA

The 1986-1987 California Valencia orange crop was estimated at 23.4 million field boxes \* as compared to 20.9 in 1985-1986 and the 26.2 million in 1984-1985. This was an percent increase from 1985-1986. The five year average for California Valencias over the 1982-1983 crop through the 1986-1987 was 24.28 million boxes.

The acreage of bearing Valencia oranges in California declined to 66,900 acres from the 67,600 in 1985-1986 and 67,300 in 1984-1985. The Arizona acreage in 1986-1987 was 6,600 as compared to the 6,800 in 1985-1986 and 6,700 in 1984-1985. The yield per acre for California in 1986-1987 was 700 cartons per acre as compared with 618 in 1985-1986 and 779 in 1984-1985. The Arizona yield was 523 as compared to 442 in 1985-1986 and 468 in 1984-1985

G R A P E F R U I T  
1986 - 1987 CROP YEAR  
UNITED STATES PRODUCTION

Total utilized grapefruit production in the U.S. for the 1986-1987 season was 63.22 million field boxes. This was nearly a 10 percent increase from the 57.47 in 1985-1986 and 12 percent over the 55.8 million in 1984-1985. The 1983-1984 crop in the U.S. was 53.6 million field boxes. California grapefruit represented only about 15 percent of the grapefruit in 1986-1987. The Florida grapefruit crop was 49.8 million boxes or about 79 percent of the total U.S. production. Production in Texas was only 1.92 million boxes as output had not recovered from the severe freeze of December, 1983. For comparison, the Texas crop in 1982-1983 was 11.2 million.

## **CALIFORNIA/ARIZONA GRAPEFRUIT**

The California grapefruit crop in 1986-1987 was estimated at 9.3 million field boxes\* of which 4.3 were out of the Desert District. The California crop in 1985-1986 was 8.1 and was 8.8 in 1984-1985. The 1983-1984 crop was 7.24 million boxes. Arizona production was put at 2.2 million boxes as compared to 2.4 in 1985-1986, 3.0 in 1984-1985 and 2.27 in 1983-1984.

The bearing acreage of grapefruit in California for 1986-1987 was put at 20,800 for all areas. The Desert District was some 9,200 acres of the total. Total California acreage for 1985-1986 was 20,900 and 21,100 in 1984-1985. Arizona acreage for the crop year was 5,900 as compared to the 5,700 in 1985-1986 and 7,100 in 1984-1985. Yield per acre in California was 894 cartons with a figure of 775 in 1985-1986 and 834 in 1984-1985. The yield per acre in 1983-1984 was 661 cartons. Arizona yield was 932 cartons in the 1986-1987 crop year, 922 for the 1985-1986 season and 944 per acre in 1984-1985.

## LEMONS

1986 - 1987 CROP YEAR

CALIFORNIA/ARIZONA

Production of lemons was 28.6 million field boxes\* in 1986-1987 of which 75 percent was California and the balance was Arizona. The total lemon crop was 18.35 in 1985-1986 and 25.8 in 1984-1985. The average lemon crop for the five year period of 1982-1983 through the 1986-1987 crop was 23.87 million boxes. The crop in 1986-1987 was nearly 36 percent larger than the crop of 1985-1986. The California lemon production was 21.5 in 1986-1987, 15.1 in 1985-1986, 19.8 in 1984-1985 and 17.25 in 1982-1983. The Arizona crop was put at 7.1 as compared to 3.25 in 1985-1986 and 6.0 in 1984-1985. A small lemon crop is produced in Florida but it is not reported by the Agricultural Statistics Board.

The bearing acreage of lemons in California for the 1986-1987 crop year was 48,400 acres as compared to the 48,000 in 1985-1986, 49,600 in 1984-1985 and 51,500 in 1983-1984. Yield per acre in cartons for California was 888 as compared with the 619 in 1985-1986 and 798 in 1984-1985. Arizona had an estimated 15,500 acres in 1986-1987, 16,500 in 1985-1986 and 17,000 in 1984-1985. Yield in Arizona for the season was 916 cartons per acre with 376 in 1985-1986 and 664 in 1984-1985.

## T A N G E R I N E S

1986 - 1987 CROP YEAR

CALIFORNIA/ARIZONA

Production of tangerines in the U.S. for the 1986-1987 crop year was estimated at 5.27 million field boxes. This compared with 4.45 in 1985-1986 and 3.43 in 1984-1985. Tangerines in California were 2.23 million boxes of the total for 1986-1987 with Arizona at .7 million boxes. Florida comprised the remaining balance of the production. California had an estimated 8,600 bearing acres with 8,500 in the 1985-1986 and in the 1984-1985 crop years. The acreage in Arizona for the 1986-1987 season was 3,200 acres with 3,300 and 3,400 respectively in the two preceding years. The yield per acre for the season was 519 cartons for California and 562 for Arizona. The previous season the yields were 424 and 576 respectively. The 1983-1984 seasons figures were 395 and 648. Tangerines in California and Arizona include tangelos, mandarines and tangors.
