LEGAL STANDARDS FOR DAIRY PRODUCTS.

(Revised to November 1, 1913.)

The percentages stated represent minimum standards in all cases, unless otherwise expressed. The department publishes these figures as given by various State authorities, but does not guarantee the correctness of the standards quoted.
