## PREFACE

This publication is a marketing summary of the 1989 New York Cabbage crop for the Western and Central New York producing area.

The information contained in this summary was obtained from reports published by the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Federal-State Market News Service, the National Agricultural Statistics Service, and Agriculture Canada's Agriculture Development Branch.

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We wish to express our sincere appreciation to the growers, shippers, brokers, processors and buyers for their cooperation.

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**WESTERN AND CENTRAL NEW YORK - CABBAGE**  
1989 CROP

**WEATHER AND CROP:**

Cabbage seedings were underway by the last week of April with temperatures unseasonably cool. By the second week of May, early planted fields had plants up, and transplanting had begun, although heavy rain and wet fields halted planting by mid-May. Cool, wet weather persisted until late May, and after a short reprieve, heavy rains began again by early June. Heavy rain continued on and off through most of June, delaying planting schedules and flooding or saturating much of the acreage in Western New York. Many fields were inaccessible to heavy equipment and could not be replanted until after July 1. July and August were generally very dry, and late planted fields progressed slowly. Head sizing was a major concern into late Fall. However, unseasonable warm weather and rainfall during late October and early November resulted in rapid sizing of the storage cabbage crop.

The adverse weather conditions contributed to a reduced yield of 2,191,000 cwt. of fresh market cabbage, approximately 5% below the 1988 crop and approximately 26% below the 1987 crop.

The late season sizing resulted in a better than expected ratio of 49% large heads, 42% medium, and 9% small size heads.

**MARKETING:**

The first FOB Shipping Point Report was issued on July 24, with prices at \$5.00 per 50 lb. bag for large, \$5.50 for medium in bags, and 50 lb. cartons of medium at \$6.00-6.50. Prices declined steadily, bottoming out at \$2.00-2.25 per bag for large cabbage at the end of November. A severe freeze in both Florida and Texas in late December resulted in a brief runup to a high of \$12.00 per bag for large in early January. Thereafter prices declined steadily except for a two week period in late February early March.

**SHIPMENTS:**

Truck shipments for the 1989-1990 marketing season, both bulk and bagged/cartons, through April, totaled 3114 truckloads (40,000 lbs.), compared to 4263 truckloads for the 1988-1989 season, and 4649 truckloads during the 1987-1988 season.

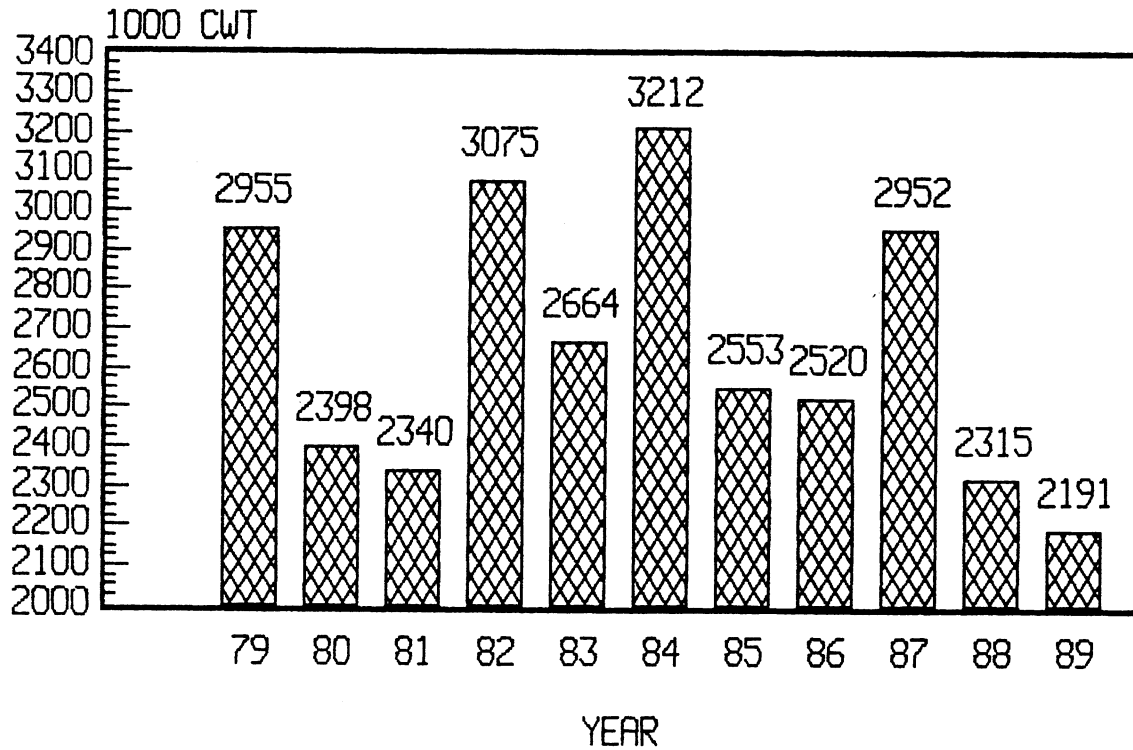

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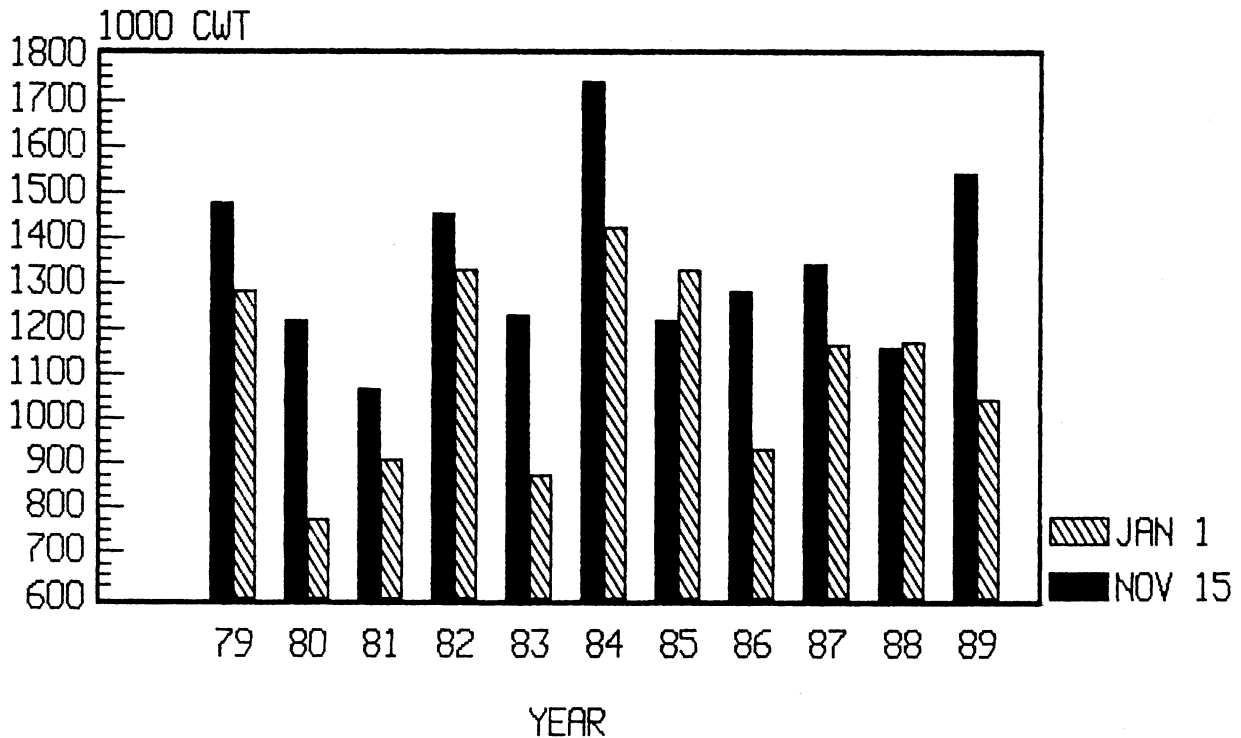
